

The Jameson Timothy Becker Memorial Scholarship

Guidelines

1. The Jameson Timothy Becker Memorial Scholarship has been established by Dr. Tim and Becky Becker in memory of their son, a popular fifth grade student at Beaver Grade School who died on April 1, 2002.
2. The Scholarship fund will be maintained through the First Security Bank, Beaver Oklahoma.
3. Only 90% of the accrued interest shall be used for the scholarship each year. The exact amount of the scholarship shall be determined each year by the family of Dr. Tim and Becky Becker or by such other individuals or entities as they might designate.
4. In honor of the valiant effort of emergency response personnel in attempting to save the life of Jameson, the scholarship will be awarded annually to a graduating senior of former graduate of a high school in Beaver County of the age of twenty-one (21) or under, who is involved with emergency response or whose parents are involved in emergency response in Beaver County.
5. For purposes of these guidelines "emergency response" shall include without implied limitation EMT, law enforcement, fire department, and ER hospital personnel.
6. To be eligible for selection for this scholarship, applications must be submitted by April 7th each year.
7. The scholarship must be used the year it is presented and may be used for attendance at a university, college, vocational or technical school.
8. One half of the scholarship will be given to the recipient after he or she has begun attending class for the first semester for the scholastic year awarded.
9. Upon successfully completing the first semester of classes and beginning the second semester, the recipient will be given the second half of the scholarship.
