In addition to this application, students should submit the following:

1. Two letters of recommendation
2. Most recent tax returns for both the student and parents
3. Entering freshmen need to provide an official copy of their high school transcript and an official copy of their ACT or SAT scores. Applications without these pieces of documentation WILL NOT be processed.
4. One billfold size picture

Students must be enrolled on a full-time basis (12 credit hours for undergraduates) to be eligible and must have a minimum grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.

Jessie Stewart Memorial Scholarship (Senior Form)

Jessie Stewart was a founding and charter member of Perryton Business and Professional Women, the predecessor organization to Panhandle Professional Women of Perryton. The scholarship in her memory encourages a Perryton High School female to pursue her higher educational goals. The scholarship is to take into account financial need, desire and ability to help self, potential to serve others, and the academic success of maintaining a minimum of 2.0 grade point average out of high school as a basis for selection of the recipient.

\$2,000 over four years (\$250 per semester) – 8 consecutive semesters (if not consecutive, scholarship ceases)

\$ 600 over two semesters (\$300 each semester) – 2 consecutive semesters (if not consecutive, scholarship ceases)
