

The Campus Principal has designated The front office and foyer area as the location for approved nonschool materials to be placed for voluntary viewing or collection.

Prior review will not be required for:

Distribution of materials by an attendee to other attendees of a school-sponsored meeting intended for adults and held after school hours. Distribution of materials by an attendee to other attendees of a community group meeting held after school hours in accordance with policy GKD(LOCAL) or a noncurriculum-related student group meeting held in accordance with FNAB(LOCAL). Distribution for electioneering purposes during the time a school facility is being used as a polling place, in accordance with state law. All nonschool materials distributed under these circumstances must be removed from district property immediately following the event at which the materials are distributed.

Dress and Grooming (All Grade Levels) The district's dress code is established to teach grooming and hygiene, prevent disruption, and minimize safety hazards. Students and parents may determine a student's personal dress and grooming standards, provided that they comply with the following:

- Underclothes must be worn and NOT shown.

Hair must be neat. No designs in hair. Hair must be a natural color.

Appropriate footwear must be worn. No house shoes or slippers may be worn.

No tight or revealing clothes of any kind. No see through clothing. No yoga pants, jazz pants, leggings, or jeggings worn as outerwear.

No tank shirts, muscle shirts, or bare midriffs. All shirts must have sleeves. Low cut tops or dresses including scoop, "V" neck and "off the shoulder" are NOT allowed.

Shorts, dresses and skirts are permitted. All must be knee length. No slits more than 3" above the knee. Leggings and tights may be worn underneath dresses and skirts. No athletic/compression type shorts allowed.

Shorts, pants, or jeans are not allowed to have holes of any kind, including strings and frays, regardless if garments are underneath.

Shorts and pants must be worn at waistline appropriately. No sagging or excessively baggy pants. Underclothing is NOT to be shown at any time.

Warm-up suits, sweat suits, and physical education apparel are NOT appropriate for outside the physical education areas.

Pajamas (tops or bottoms) are NOT allowed.

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Head coverings are not permitted. Head coverings include but are not limited to: sweatbands, caps, hats, bandanas, skull caps (unless item is religious based and approved)

No large chains, bulky jewelry or accessories.

Visible body piercings other than earrings are not allowed

Boys may wear stud earrings only (4th – 12th grade).

No gang related apparel.

Inappropriate or offensive tattoos must be covered.

If the principal determines that a student's grooming or clothing violates the school's dress code, the student will be given an opportunity to correct the problem at school. If not corrected, the student may be assigned to in-school suspension for the remainder of the day, until the problem is corrected, or until a parent or designee brings an acceptable change of clothing to the school. Repeated offenses may result in more serious disciplinary action in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct.

The administration reserves the right to amend the dress code list and to ban additional items without prior notification to the student. Banquets and awards ceremonies will follow all dress code guidelines. Refer to items listed below for detailed clothing descriptions.
