Directions: You have until the end of the semester (about 8 weeks) to choose and complete 10 hands-on projects from the Floral BINGO board below. Although it is ideal to create a vertical, horizontal, or diagonal BINGO, I understand that you may find activities that do not line up exactly on the board, and that's okay!

Click on each project below to find a link to a tutorial or multiple options to choose from to help guide you in making your own creation. It is not necessary to copy the tutorials exactly – it's just an example/visual to help you get started. Search the internet (Pinterest, Youtube, etc.) for more tutorial examples if needed.

Please display high school-level effort and creativity for the projects you choose. Example: *Make a minimum of 3 cupcake liner flowers total to complete the art project.* Also, please try to hide “mechanics!” Such as glue, wire, string, etc. Messy, careless work is unacceptable.

Do your best with the tools and resources you have at home or with what you find in nature nearby (*with permission!*). You may also buy supplies if you wish, but it is not required. Be creative and have fun! Can't wait to see your creations!

HOW TO TURN IN PROJECTS

You will see TWO Floral BINGO major grade assignments in Google Classroom with the TWO separate due dates listed below. Please **add/create a new Google Slides presentation** for *each* major grade assignment.

You only need 5 slides for each presentation - 1 slide for each project made. Each slide must include:

1. **Picture of completed project:**
 - a. Take a picture of each completed project **with your student ID included in the picture**. If you currently do not have your student ID, please use an alternative form of ID or write your first and last name on a piece of paper or somewhere visible on the project.
 - b. If possible, please take pictures with good lighting and a solid-colored background (*Example: Create your project on solid paper or poster, or lay/arrange your project on a table, lean your project against a wall, or use a trifold background like we do in class*) so it is easy for me to see and grade online.
2. **Description of completed project:**
 - a. Title of the project (*use the titles on the BINGO board*)
 - b. List of the supplies used (*tools, mechanics, fresh materials, etc.*).
 - If you used fresh materials for your project, please also include where you got the fresh materials from.

DUE DATES

Projects 1-5 due by **Friday, April 24th** = 5 daily grades, 1 major grade.

Projects 6-10 due by **Friday, May 22nd** = 5 daily grades, 1 major grade.

Don't forget to click “TURN IN” once each of your Google Slides presentations are complete!
