Dear Cook County School District 130 Family and Community Members:

The Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) released our annual School Report Card on October 30, 2019, at www.illinoisreportcard.com. The Report Card shows how well our District is progressing against a wide range of educational goals. The Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) has established high standards that apply to all schools Statewide. Likewise, we hold high expectations for all students at Cook County School District 130.

The State’s funding and accountability systems recognize that different schools in different communities need unique supports to reach those high expectations – just as each individual child needs different tools and encouragement to succeed. In addition, the State’s support and accountability system includes a summative designation based on multiple factors. This summative designation allows the State to compare schools across Illinois and to direct additional supports as needed.

For the first time ever, these designations and academic indicators appear alongside site-based expenditures – or how much money our District spends per student at each site. With these two data points, we have the opportunity to take a closer look at the relationship between financial investments and student outcomes.

All schools in Illinois will qualify for one of the four summative designations below:
