Analogies can be used to compare objects and their functions.

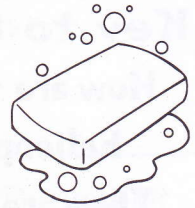

How are the second two words related?**

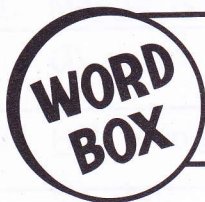
broom, sweep soap, clean

The purpose of a broom is to sweep. The purpose of soap is to clean. We can compare the two word pairs by saying they describe objects and functions. Another way of saying this is "Broom is to sweep as soap is to clean."
