

# Lesson 29: The Right Location .....

Analogies can be used to compare people and the places they are found.



## Key to Solving

How are the first two words related? How are the second two words related?

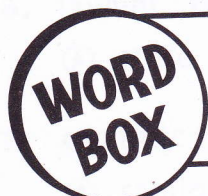
teacher, classroom      scientist, laboratory



A teacher might be found in a classroom. A scientist might be found in a laboratory. We can compare the two word pairs by saying they describe people and the places they work. Another way of saying this is "Teacher is to classroom as scientist is to laboratory."
