

# Lesson 30: Comparing Locations .....

Analogies can help you compare word pairs of different people, animals, or objects and their locations.



## Key to Solving

**How are the words in the first pair related? How are the words in the second pair related? How is the second pair similar to the first pair?**



**Journalist is to newspaper as chef is to restaurant.**

**A journalist works at a newspaper. A chef works at a restaurant. In this way, the relationship between journalist and newspaper is like the relationship between chef and restaurant.**
