



COVID Outdoor Guidelines-Football

Face Coverings

Masks, gaiters, etc. are REQUIRED for the following while at athletic facilities:

- Washington school employees, gate workers, and concession workers.
- Washington students when they can not practice social distancing. Washington students are required to carry a face covering at all times.

Face Coverings

Masks, gaiters, etc. are SUGGESTED for the following while at athletic facilities:

All participants (officials, coaches, players), security, spectators, media, and sports medicine/training.

Exceptions for Face Coverings

Students who are actively participating, and those individuals with medical documentation that states they should not wear a face covering.

For the safety of everyone, we request that you follow the guidelines below:

1. We ask that spectators exercise physical distancing, in the bleachers, concession stand, entry lines, and restrooms.
2. For Washington patrons and students, we encourage you to purchase passes ahead of time. PASS information is available by emailing petaylor@wps-isd.com (Family and Student Passes). Senior citizen passes are available at no charge for in-district seniors 60 & up. Information must be sent by email prior to passes being purchased or picked up.
3. While we believe sportsmanship is paramount to the development of young people, at this time, we will recommend no handshaking between opposing teams.
4. For participants, coaches, and officials, no shared water bottles, towels, clothing, or equipment.
5. Only necessary personnel will be allowed in the press box and concession stand.
6. Please wash hands thoroughly when visiting the restroom.

For football games at Washington:

1. When teams are in locker rooms, we suggest they wear face coverings and practice social distancing.
2. Each team/school is in charge of their own personnel and wellness checks leading up to and following each event, based on their school guidelines.
3. Each team is in charge of sanitizing their equipment, etc.
4. No handshakes or fist bumps before, during, or after the game.
5. Game officials may have additional guidelines.
6. Game night personnel/workers/media on sidelines are asked to wear a face covering and distance themselves away from other people.
