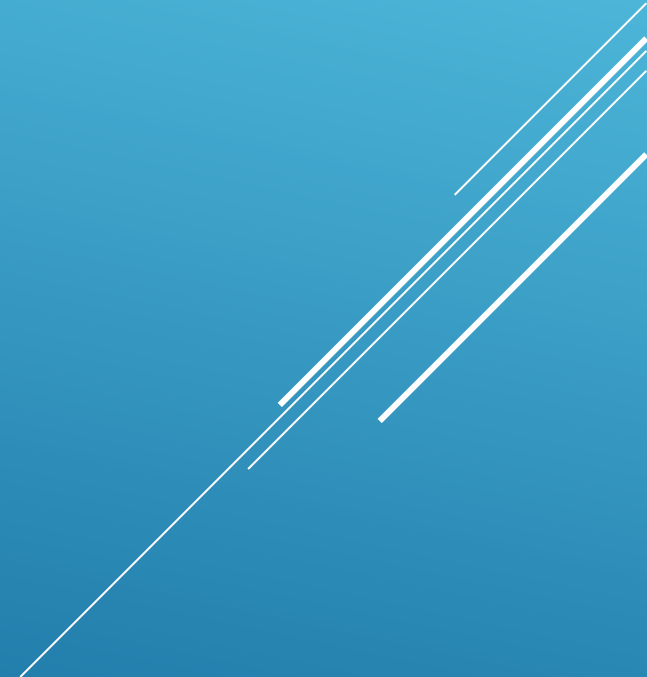

Technology

- Decatur's new website
 - Remains under construction
 - Fundamental and critical information is available(State Required Information, campus locations, departments, etc..).
 - Call System is setup with employee and student contact information
 - Employee information is manually uploaded (contact info can only be seen by web admin)
 - Student contact information is automatically synced with Eschool
- Student Devices
 - All 1:1 devices purchased for 2019-2020 school year are currently in use.
 - We are in our 7th year of being 1:1 in the High School
 - Refurbishing old devices for loan/replacements
 - Remaining Middle School Acer chromebooks will be repurposed for our CTE classrooms once they are replaced
