

Dear Tornado family,

We are embracing the opportunity to meet the challenge of educating our students while keeping our community safe by providing distance education due to COVID-19. Education and health are still first priority. Students are expected to adhere to deadlines assigned by teachers through Google classroom or packet work. This is **NOT** an extension of Spring Break. We are still in school, though we are in a different format with the distance education. This is our short term plan. We will tentatively resume school on April 1, 2020, but we will be reevaluating the COVID-19 situation throughout the next few weeks of school closure.

Below is our plan by level.

Elementary Plan

PK-3

- Send home a packet
- Parents will send a picture of the completed day's work by 8:00 p.m. via text, email, or Remind App
- Grades will come from the daily pictures of the student's completed work, failing to submit daily pictures will result in a 0 for the day's assignments
- Follow schedule specificities assigned by teacher

4 and 5

- Log in to Google classroom to complete all work
- Participation will be a major grade factor as well as the work completed via Google classroom
- **IMPORTANT** to follow schedule specificities assigned by teachers
- Notify teacher's if student is not able to get on to complete assigned work to meet assigned schedule

JH Plan

- Students will adhere to schedules according to their grade level
- Schedules will be handed out via paper as well as posted in Google classroom
- Students should log in to their Google classroom **EVERY DAY**
- Grades will come from daily attendance by logging in to Google classroom daily, as well as assignments in Google classroom and Edgenuity

HS Plan

- Students will be required to check in **EVERY DAY** to Google classroom for assignment instructions from each teacher
- Grades will come from students logging in to Google classroom daily to complete assignments within Google classroom as well as Edgenuity
- Deadlines inside Google classroom will be strict and failure to complete the assignments in Google classroom or Edgenuity will result in a 0

On Thursday: **PLEASE BRING DEVICE YOU PLAN ON USING**

- Pre-K, Kinder, and 1 – Parents please come pick up take-home packet from their student's teacher between 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. on Thursday
- Second through fifth grades— Parents please come pick up take-home packet from their student's teacher between 12:00 p.m. and 3:30 p.m. on Thursday
- If you have siblings, we will work with you to get things picked up

On Friday: **PLEASE BRING DEVICE YOU PLAN ON USING**

- Junior High – Parents and students please come pick up instructions from student's teachers between 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. on Friday
- High School – Parents and students please come pick up instructions from student's teachers between 12:00 p.m. and 3:30 p.m. on Friday
- If you have siblings, we will work with you to get things picked up

Transportation:

- Transportation by arrangement ONLY on Thursday and Friday for both pick up and drop off
