

Re: Inclement Weather Procedures

Dear Parents,

I hope you and your child are enjoying a great school year! The North Rock Creek Faculty is working diligently to improve outcomes for *all* of our students. We appreciate your continued support of North Rock Creek School.

As the colder season approaches, I wanted to take an opportunity to communicate North Rock Creek School's procedures regarding school cancellation, if needed. There are two major objectives I want to make clear in regards to snow day(s): communicating school closing information and rescheduling the day(s) if necessary. First, the methods by which we will communicate school closings is through our local television stations (i.e. KFOR (4), KOCO (5), & KWTW (9)), our school's website (www.nrc.k12.ok.us), SchoolMessenger (robocalls), and our school's answering machine (405-275-3473). Please refer to these forms of communication if inclement weather should arise. Second, North Rock Creek School has adopted a calendar that exceeds the minimum state requirement of 1,080 hours per school year. Therefore, we will communicate with you, in the event of snow days, whether or not make up days are required.

To view the school calendar and school events in general, go to www.nrc.k12.ok.us for the latest information. Move your cursor over the "real-time" calendar on the left side of the home screen to view day-by-day events. We feel this calendar feature on our website is beneficial to the community.
