## Report and Disclosure of the Student Portion of the CRRSA ACT (HEERF II) and ARP (HEERF III)

Mid-America Technology Center acknowledges that the institution has used or will use the amount allocated from the student portion of the CRRSA ACT (HEERF II - \$126,822.00) and ARP (HEERF III - \$327,594.00) funds for a total funds of \$454,416.00 received under Section 314(a)(1) of the CRRSAA Act and ARP ACT to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

- 1. The total amount of funds MATC received on January 28, 2021 from the U.S. Department of Education for distribution for emergency grants to students is **\$126,822** and **\$327,594.00** on May 13, 2021.
- 2. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students for the quarter ending December 31, 2021, was **\$112,600.00**
- 3. The total number of students at MATC eligible to participate in programs and meet the eligibility to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants was <u>141</u>.
- 4. The total number of students, as of December 31, 2021, who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant was *111*.
- 5. The methods used to determine which and how much students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants are as follows
  - a. MATC students completed an application for approval of emergency funds. Students receiving Pell Funds were prioritized with exceptional need.
