

Hartley ISD PARENTAL NOTICE OF COVID 19 PROCEDURES

Attendance and Enrollment

1. Per Texas Education Code (TEC), §25.092, students must attend 90% of the days a course is offered (with some exceptions) in order to be awarded credit for the course and/or to be promoted to the next grade. This requirement remains in force during the 2020-21 school year.
2. Given the public health situation, student attendance may be earned through the delivery of virtual instruction.
3. Any parent may request that their student be offered virtual instruction. **Virtual instruction will be much more challenging and time consuming than it was last semester. Students who choose virtual instruction will be required to attend classes daily and do the assignments daily in accordance with the new state regulations.** Parent who choose virtual instruction for their child must notify the principal no later than one week prior to the beginning of the six weeks period. If a parent who chose virtual instruction and wants their child to switch to an on-campus instruction can do so at the end of the six weeks period. **There will be no switching between on campus instruction and remote instruction during the six weeks period.** Students who wish to participate in extra curricular activities must go to school on campus. Students who wish to attend extracurricular activities as a spectator must go to school on campus.
4. Hartley ISD will provide daily on-campus instruction for students who follow the required public health procedures as prescribed by the state or county and whose parents wish them to attend on campus each day, subject to school closure.
