The Class of 1968 has fond memories of our time at TCHS and are proud to establish the Class of 1968 Scholarship for a graduating senior seeking to continue their education. The Class of 1968 has established a scholarship fund to reward a TCHS graduating senior who embodies strong character traits.

The annual award, to be presented through the TCHS Foundation, will be a \$500 cash scholarship to be applied to the postsecondary venue the student plans to attend. A certificate of award will be given during the spring award ceremony, Evening of Excellence. The awardee will notify Mrs. Leta Deines of their school of choice by June following commencement. ### **APPLICATION FORM**

#### **I. Nature of scholarship**

Beginning with the graduating Class of 2019 at Trego Community High School, WaKeeney, Kansas, the Class of 1968 Scholarship will provide for one \$500 scholarship to be awarded to a graduating senior from each graduating class at TCHS. This scholarship must be used to attend a college, university or technical school for postsecondary education. The award will be paid directly to the awardee's school of choice.

#### **II. Selection Procedure**

Each graduating senior of each year's graduating class will be eligible to make application. An April 1 application deadline will be set each year. At least three people shall make-up the selection committee consisting of TCHS school personnel. Recipients will be announced at the annual Evening of Excellence awards ceremony.

#### **III. Selection Criteria**

- Student must be a graduating senior who plans to attend a college, university or technical school for postsecondary education.

- Student must show leadership as exemplified by their role(s) in a major extra-curricular activity (varsity sport, band, cheerleading, musical/drama, and club leadership are examples).
- Student must exemplify the characteristics of a team player.
- Student must have at least a 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
- Student must be an individual who quietly does his best as a student-athlete-participant and has not, to this point, received due recognition as a major team participant.
- Student will be selected based on recommendations from coaches, teachers, sponsors, and administrators.
