

## **Roberts L. Lander Memorial Scholarship**

Roberts L. (Bob) Lander was a strong believer and ardent supporter of college education. He graduated from Michigan State University in 1939. He felt that his college education had been very important in his life. Even though he grew up in a time when the majority of females did not pursue a college education, he believed strongly that women should also pursue education and careers traditionally dominated by males.

He lived his life giving help of both time and money to others when he saw their need. He would be very happy to know that a memorial scholarship had been created in his name. Some day the recipients of this gift will be able to contribute gifts of their own to deserving, young people. That would make him even happier.

**Nature of the Scholarship:** Beginning with the graduating class of 2002, the Roberts L. Lander Family will provide for a \$500 scholarship to be awarded to a graduating senior who is a Trego Community High School student and an active participant at the Ogallah Christian Church. This scholarship must be used at an accredited post-secondary school. Once the scholarship is awarded, it will be paid directly to the financial aid office of the student's choice. It will be paid in two installments of \$250 each, paid at the beginning of the fall and spring semesters. The student must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.00 during the first semester to receive the second installment.

**Selection Criteria:** Scholastic record and potential, leadership abilities, character, and responsible involvement in school, community, and Christian activities.

**Personal Information:** Submit a resume' which includes the following information: name, address, names of all household members and indicate if any will also be attending college, high school activities and offices held, special honors and/or awards received during high school, any jobs held during high school, church related activities, and intended college and field of study.

**Academic Information:** Include a copy of your high school transcript

**References:** Include two letters of recommendation that speak to any or all the selection criteria

**Essay:** A short essay discussing how your Christian faith has influenced your decisions and goals.
