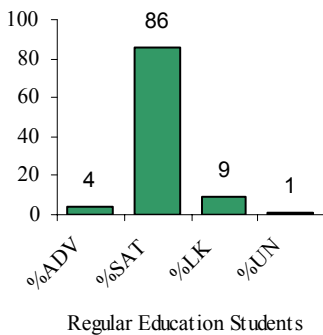

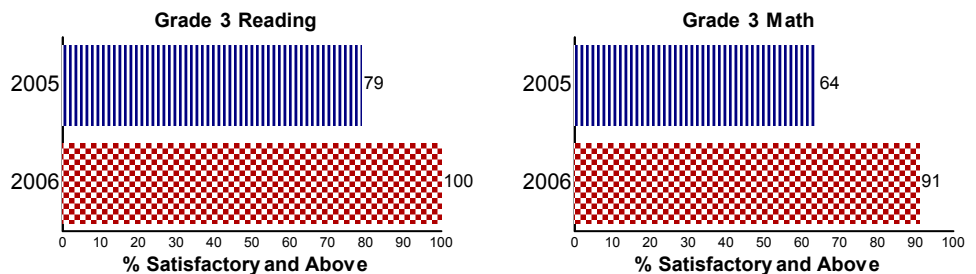


State Results Grade 3 Mathematics

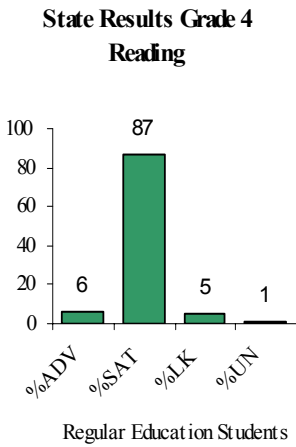

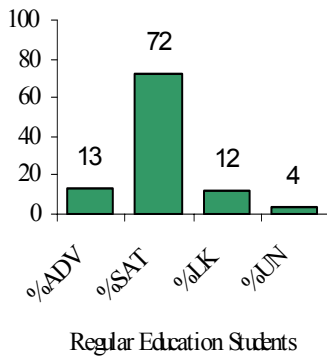

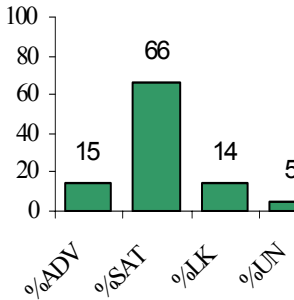

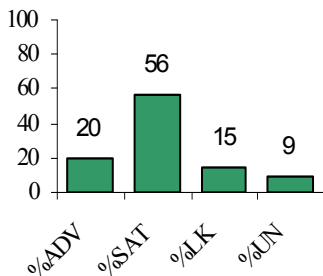
