

Mason is hosting and would like to invite you to a Small Schools Scholastic Meet, Tuesday, February 13, 2018.

Students from the 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th grades will compete in the following academic areas:

Schools attending will be responsible for developing, administering, and scoring two sets of tests in the specified area, which will be assigned. This is greatly appreciated by the Mason School System. EACH TEACHER DEVELOPING AND ADMINISTERING A TEST SHOULD ALIGN WITH THE OKLAHOMA ACADEMIC STANDARDS.

TEACHERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR TESTS. Testing period of forty-five (45) minutes. Tests should be such that a 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th place can be determined. (We suggest a tiebreaker question be used at the end of each test.)

NO STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN MORE THAN TWO (2) TESTS.

◆ No more than 75 questions and 2 tie-breaker questions.

◆ Have one or more fast scoring keys for your test.

A tabulation room will be available at the north end of the gym. You may obtain aid in grading your test there. **To make the scoring process faster, we request that each school turn in a list of their students who are participating in the meet.**

A list of all students participating and their test scores should be completed and turned in to Mr. Williams after each test is administered. (Forms will be available in the tabulation room.)

You will need to bring twenty-Six (26) copies of each test for which you are responsible.

Individual trophies will be awarded for 1st and 2nd place. Neck ribbon medallions will be presented to the 3rd, 4th, and 5th place finishers in each academic and grade area tested.

The awards will cost approximately \$600.00. We feel we should charge a \$35.00 per school entry fee. Please make check payable to Mason School Activity Fund.

All participants should meet in the gymnasium at 9:00 AM. Testing will begin at 9:15 AM, 10:15 AM, and 11:15 AM. A short assembly will be held in the gym at approximately 12:30 for presentation of awards.

A concession will be open from 9:00-12:30. Students not being tested should be in the concession or gym area.

A hospitality room will be available in the tabulation room. (North end of gym.)

Each school administrator or representative should pick up one packet with tests and results from tabulation room at 1:00.

Tests will be returned to the participating school representative.
Awards given at presentation ceremony will be final.

If for any reason a school cannot attend this Scholastic Meet or make the necessary assigned tests, please notify Mr. Williams. It would be very disappointing for a group of students to have studied for a test and the test is not available.
