Re: Driving/Parking on Campus

We need your help. If you have been on campus to drop off or pick up a child, you may have noticed problems with traffic. During the next two years, we will be dealing with the highway project and construction/demolition of buildings. For the safety of our students, staff, and community, please follows these rules:

Morning Drop-Off

- All Elementary and Middle School students will need to be dropped between the new gym and the flower bed. **PLEASE DO NOT STOP ON THE HILL BY THE MIDDLE SCHOOL TO DROP OFF YOUR STUDENT!**
- All High School students will need to be dropped off at the cross walk between the senior parking lot and Old Main.
- If you are walking your student to their school building, please park between the student parking lot (behind the old Little Red School House) and the tennis courts.
- Except for school buses, no traffic will be allowed on the road between the Vocational Building and the old Little Red School House beginning at 7:30 am. **PLEASE DO NOT PARK IN FRONT OF THE CAFETERIA in the mornings. This area is for buses only,**
- Reminder: No left turn out of campus onto Highway 65 from 7:30 am to 8:30 am.

After School Pick-up

- Drivers on campus picking up Elementary students may begin lining up in front of the cafeteria at **2:45**. The first car in the car rider line will need to stop before the crosswalk between Allbright Hall and the Middle School until 2:40. Once your student is loaded in your vehicle, you will leave campus by the road between the Vocational Building and the old Little Red School House.
- Middle and High School Students will be picked up in the grass area between the student parking (behind the old Little Red School House) and the tennis courts.
