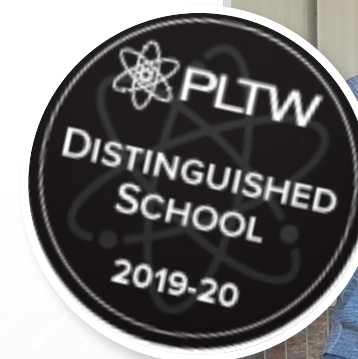
NAMED A **DISTINGUISHED SCHOOL** FOR STEM AND CAREER LEARNING PROGRAM
