

CONSENT/OPT-OUT FORM

To the Parents of _____

The District is required by federal law to notify you and obtain your consent or denial (opt-out) for your child to participate in certain school activities. The activities include a student survey, analysis, or evaluation that concerns one or more of the following areas, known as "protected information surveys."

1. Political affiliations or beliefs of the student or student's family;
2. Mental or psychological problems or the students or student's family;
3. Sex behavior or attitudes.
4. Illegal, antisocial, self-incriminating, or demeaning behavior;
5. Critical appraisals of others with whom respondents have close family relationships;
6. Legally recognized privileged relationships, such as with lawyers, doctors, or ministers;
5. Religious practices, affiliations, or beliefs of the student or parents;
8. Income, other than as required by law to determine program eligibility.

This requirement also applies to the collection, disclosure, or use of student information for marketing purposes ("marketing surveys") and certain physical exams and screening.

At the current time, there are no activities requiring parental notice and consent or opt-out for the 2019-2020 school year. Please note that this notice and authority to consent transfer from parent to student when the student reaches 18 or is an emancipated minor under state law.

If an activity that would fall in this category arises, parents will be notified and permission or the right to opt-out will be given.
