How to find my child's Unique Access Code?

• When parents visit <u>TexasAssessment.gov</u>, they can click on the link "Find My Access Code" located at the bottom of the purple login box. After entering their child's first name, date of birth, and Social Security or "S" number, they will be provided an Access Code so they can log in to the portal.

What is an "S" number?

• An S number is a state-approved alternate ID number assigned to a child either because a Social Security number is not available, or the parent chose not to release a Social Security number.
