Dear Parents/Guardians & Staff,

We are notifying all families that Pineywoods Community Academy has received notice that an individual on PCA campus has been lab confirmed for COVID-19. The individual was last present on campus, Wednesday, January 6, 2021. Upon notification, Pineywoods Community Academy COVID-19 Response Team began all procedures necessary for notification of the health department, notification of individuals exposed, and disinfection of necessary areas. Due to privacy requirements, PCA will not be releasing the name of the individual or details that may identify him or her.

Pineywoods Community Academy staff will contact any individuals determined to be in close contact with the lab confirmed individual. Individuals that were in close contact will remain off campus for up to 14 days to ensure they do not have the virus and to help control any further spread.

While we do not have reason to believe that those who were not in close contact with the lab confirmed individual have reason to be concerned, PCA asks that you, as always, watch for symptoms of COVID-19.

Any of the following symptoms may indicate a possible COVID-19 infection:

- Temperature of 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit or higher when taken by mouth;
- Sore throat;
- New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (or, for students with a chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from normal).
- Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain; or
- New onset of severe headaches, especially with fever.

If any member of the PCA community begins to experience any of these symptoms, we urge you to contact your physician. We encourage anyone in the PCA community who is lab confirmed for COVID-19 to notify the school by contacting the campus principal.
