
- Collaborate and support the district and school efforts in achieving an "A" rating from the state

### **CONTINENTAL SCHOOL DISTRICT GOALS**

#### Goal #1: Academic Rigor & Excellence

- Establish high expectations for increased student performance as measured by the AASA State Assessment.
  - 10% of Continental Students Grades 3rd-8th as measured by the AASA, who were below proficiency in June 2022, will move to proficiency and above in ELA and Mathematics by June 2023.
  - Continental School as measured by AASA will earn an "A" Letter grade by June 2025.
- Monthly Review Link IT/Concentra data
  - 100% of Continental teachers will monitor weekly/bi-weekly student academic progress using Standards Based Formatives as measured by NWEA MAP from August to May 2023.

### CONTINENTAL SCHOOL DISTRICT GOALS Continued

#### **Goal #2: Safe and Orderly Learning Environment**

- Ensure the emotional needs of students are being met as measured by resources and supports the unique needs of ALL students.
  - 100% of Continental Staff will implement the Positive Behavior Intervention Support System to create a positive social-emotional environment as measured by quarterly disciplinary reports, student climate survey, and Frontline Domain 4 evidence through the 2022-2023 school year.
- Conduct a security audit (develop smart goals after board mtg.)
  - Continental School will work with state local law enforcement agencies to conduct an annual security audit.
- Increase the safety of the use of technology
  - Student Digital Driver's License/ Student Cyber Security will be earned annually for all students.
  - Teacher Technology Usage form will be signed annually by all staff.

### CONTINENTAL SCHOOL DISTRICT GOALS CONTINUED

#### Goal #3: Financial Strength

- Maintain sound fiscal stewardship of financial resources
  - Continental District Leadership Team will monitor expenditures of Federal and State grants, monthly, using a Google monitoring spreadsheet during the 2022-23 school year.
- Regularly monitor audit findings to address material weaknesses
  - Continental District Leadership Team will meet monthly to monitor procedures enlisted to eliminate material weaknesses annually.
- Develop a Capital Needs Strategic Plan Budget
  - Continental Business and Finance Director will create and maintain a Capital Needs Strategic Plan Budget that is informed by a Capital Budget Committee which will meet quarterly during the 2022-23 school year.
