Training Meeting of the Board of Trustees**

This meeting is a workshop for board training purposes as required under section 11.159 of the Texas Education Code. No action will be taken at this meeting.

A quorum of trustees will be present at the in-person meeting at 7200 I-40 West, Amarillo, Texas. Members of the public may attend the meeting in person, and may participate in public comment at the meeting in accordance with Board Policy BED(LOCAL). Alternatively, members of the public may submit written public comments by emailing publiccomments@amaisd.org. Public comments must be received no later than 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 25, 2021, and must include the name of the person submitting the email. Please write 'Public Comment' in the subject line. Comments will be forwarded to the Board prior to the beginning of the meeting and will be acknowledged during the meeting.

A recording of the meeting will be available for viewing on the District's website. In accordance with Governor Abbott's Temporary Suspension of Open Meeting Laws, the Board's presiding officer may participate in the meeting via videoconference. The Teambuilding Trainer will participate via video conference.

A Training Meeting of the Board of Trustees of Amarillo ISD will be held Friday, February 26, 2021, beginning at 8:30 AM in the Board Room, Rod Schroder Education Support Center, 7200 Interstate 40 West, Amarillo, Texas 79106.

The subjects to be discussed or considered or upon which any formal action may be taken are as listed below. Items do not have to be taken in the order shown on this meeting notice.

2. Teambuilding Training Workshop - the training session is to fulfill the requirements for board-superintendent teambuilding training under the Texas Administrative Code 19 TAC 61.1(b)(4). The Board will participate with the Superintendent in this teambuilding workshop, facilitated by a presenter from the Texas Association of School Boards. The purpose of the training is to enhance the effectiveness of the board-superintendent team, and to assess the team's continuing education needs, based on the Framework for School Board Development. Trustees and the Superintendent will engage in a discussion regarding governance effectiveness, goal-setting, and the roles and responsibilities of board members. The workshop will last a minimum of three hours; no action will be taken.

If, during the course of the meeting, the Board determines it should go into a closed meeting, the Board will conduct the closed meeting in accordance with the Texas Open Meeting Act, Government Code Chapter 551, Subchapters D and E. Before any closed meeting is convened, the presiding officer will publicly identify the section or sections of the Act authorizing the closed

meeting. The Board may consult telephonically with outside legal counsel pursuant to Texas Government Code 551.129. All final votes, actions, or decisions will be taken in open meeting.
