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Goals

Goal 1: Student Achievement: AISD will increase student achievement for all students.

Performance Objective 1: In the 2020-2021 school year, South Georgia Elementary will strive to achieve an increase of 5% for grades 1-5 every six weeks on reading and math assessment scores entered into Eduphoria with an overall 90% or better on end of year assessments and/or STAAR.

Performance Objective 2: South Georgia Elementary will offer all students a challenging, high-quality ELAR curriculum and will provide research-based instruction to ensure an overall 90% or better success rate in reading scores as measured by IStation Overall by the end of 2020-2021 which will decrease the performance gap between sub-populations.

Performance Objective 3: South Georgia Elementary will offer all students a challenging, high-quality Math curriculum and will provide research-based instruction to ensure an overall 90% or better success rate as measured by campus summative assessments, AVMR constructs, and STAAR assessments by the end of 2020-2021 which will decrease the performance gap between sub-populations.

Performance Objective 4: During the 2020-2021 school year, South Georgia will improve the Clarity Survey results in the area of personal technology use by increasing the use of technology in the classroom and collaborating with students and parents to learn to utilize technology both at school and at home to support the learning of academic content.

Performance Objective 5: For the 2020-21 school year, South Georgia Elementary will improve the RTI process in order to meet the needs of 100% of the students identified in need of additional academic support across grade levels.

Performance Objective 6: In the 2020-2021 school year, South Georgia Elementary will strive to achieve an increase of 10% for African American students and students receiving special education services in grades 1-5 every six weeks on reading and math assessment scores entered into Eduphoria with an overall 90% or better.

Goal 2: Student Transition: AISD will graduate every student prepared for college, career or military service.

Performance Objective 1: During the 2020-2021 school year, South Georgia will provide a variety of activities to our students so that 100% of our students feel their transition from one grade level to the next was successful and they have information about options for learning beyond high school.

Performance Objective 2: 100% of the South Georgia students will participate in Career Awareness activities thoughout the 2020-21 school year.

Goal 3: Cost Effectiveness: AISD will use resources to ensure academic achievement by all students.

Performance Objective 1: For the 2020-2021 school year, South Georgia Elementary will use all funds efficiently and effectively to improve instruction and student achievement.

Goal 4: Customer Service: AISD will build positive relationships with its stakeholders in a safe learning environment.

Performance Objective 1: For the 2020-2021 school year, South Georgia will provide ongoing parent training and sponsored events so that 100% of students feel connected and safe.

Performance Objective 2: In order to reduce office referrals by 5% from 160 to 145 for the 2020-2021 school year, South Georgia Elementary will promote a consistent discipline model and provide socio-emotional support through a designated curriculum to promote respectful, responsible, and safe behavior by all students.

Performance Objective 3: South Georgia will maintain an attendance rate at or above 96% for all students and all subgroups for the 2020-2021 school year.

Performance Objective 4: During the 2020-2021 school year, South Georgia Elementary will give parents several opportunities to participate in their child's education and will increase participation at campus events by 10% (from 52% to 62%) including in-class and virtual events.

Goal 5: Quality Staff: AISD will recruit, develop and retain a quality and diverse staff.
