

REPORT ON VIOLENT AND/OR CRIMINAL OFFENSES

- North Lamar ISD had no report of violent and/or criminal offenses during the 2018-2019 school year.
- NLISD has its own police department and employs four police officers. Officers are housed on campuses and regularly interact with students to encourage positive behavior and prevent negative behavior. Each officer brings specialized knowledge of the law, local and national crime trends, and safety procedures to the campus. They possess a skill set unique among both law enforcement and education personnel that enables them to protect the district while supporting the educational mission.
- All campuses at NLISD screen and track everyone coming into the schools and keep unwanted entrants out through the Raptor Visitor Management school security system. The program screens for sex offenders, alerts of custody violations, and provides districtwide reporting for all visitors.
- Additional safety features were added to the exterior door locking systems and outside doors remained locked.
- NLISD added armed staff and implemented the ALICE (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate) program. The program provides training and preparedness solutions to help curb crimes of violence.
