"Summer Slide" is when kids tend to lose some of the things they've learned during the previous school year. Let's keep their brains working this summer!

## **OUR GOAL:**

- Help students retain what they learned this year
- Improve math and reading skills
- Build our students' confidence for next year

#### HOW?

We are challenging our K-8<sup>TH</sup> grade students to:

- Spend 10 minutes per day on i-Ready lessons AND/OR
- Spend 10 minutes per day reading

## PRIZES!!!

- Prizes will be given for every student who completes 10 hours of i-Ready lessons OR reads for 10 hours and turns in their reading log. (This is less than 10 minutes per day on each)
- BONUS PRIZE IF YOU DO BOTH!
- Prizes will also be rewarded to the student in each grade that logs the most hours in i-Ready AND to the student who turns in the most hours on their reading log.
- Every hour you spend on either i-Ready or reading will put your name in a drawing for even more prizes!
- NOTE: i-Ready minutes must be completed by July 31<sup>st</sup> because the software will be unavailable for the first 2 weeks of August, but reading minutes can continue until the first day of school!

#### **HOW TO PARTICIPATE**

We are sending home a tracker for your student to keep track of their minutes. (i-Ready also keeps track of their minutes in the system). These will be turned in to your child's school office at Meet the Teacher or the first day of school, and prizes will be awarded the second week of school.

## **WHAT IS I-READY?**

- I-Ready is an educational software program that our K-5 and some of our middle school students are already using at school. The program provides a customized learning path for your child based on their current ability level, and it changes with them as they learn. If students are behind, it can help them catch up. If they have already mastered their grade level, they can keep advancing and get head for next year.
- NOTE: There are educational games available on i-Ready, but those minutes will not count toward their total. We will run a report at the end of July to see the totals that each student has spent on i-Ready lessons.
- To access i-Ready, students will go to https://clever.com/in/nlclever, then log in with their school email and password, or use a QR code the teachers can send home. Then choose i-Ready from the list. Videos on how to log on and use i-Ready will also be posted on our website. More reading/i-Ready trackers can also be printed from the website.
