

BY-LAWS

ARTICLE I: NAME OF COMMITTEE

THE NAME OF THIS COMMITTEE IS THE FORT COBB-BROXTON J.O.M. INDIAN EDUCATION COMMITTEE.

ARTICLE II: OBJECTIVES

THE OBJECTIVES OF THE COMMITTEE ARE:

- A. TO PROMOTE THE WELFARE OF INDIAN CHILDREN AND YOUTH IN HOME, SCHOOL, COMMUNITY, AND THE TRIBE.
- B. TO RAISE THE STANDARDS OF SCHOOL ACHIEVEMENT OF INDIAN CHILDREN.
- C. TO SECURE ADEQUATE PROGRAMS FOR THE CARE AND PROTECTION OF INDIAN CHILDREN AND YOUTH.
- D. TO BRING INTO CLOSER RELATION THE HOME AND THE SCHOOL, THE PARENTS AND SCHOOL, SO THE PARENTS AND TEACHERS MAY COOPERATE IN THE EDUCATION OF INDIAN CHILDREN AND YOUTH.
- E. TO DEVELOP BETWEEN EDUCATORS AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC SUCH UNITED EFFORTS AS WILL SECURE FOR ALL CHILDREN AND YOUTH THE HIGHEST ADVANTAGES IN PHYSICAL, MENTAL, SOCIAL, AND SPIRITUAL EDUCATION.

ARTICLE III: MEMBERSHIP

ANY PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF INDIAN STUDENTS WITH ANY DEGREE OF INDIAN BLOOD ENROLLED IN THE CONTRACTED SCHOOLS MAY BECOME A MEMBER OF THIS COMMITTEE.

- A. SIZE OF COMMITTEE:
SEVEN MEMBERS CONSISTING OF - FIVE (5) PARENTS OF INDIAN STUDENTS
ONE (1) TEACHER
ONE (1) STUDENT FROM GRADE 7-12
- B. SELECTION OF MEMBERS:
PARENTS OR GUARDIANS OF INDIAN STUDENTS AND INDIAN STUDENTS IN GRADES 7-12 SHALL ELECT COMMITTEE MEMBERS.
- C. TERM OF MEMBERSHIP:
TERMS SHALL BE FOR ONE (1) YEAR.
- D. VOTING RIGHTS:
EACH MEMBER SHALL BE ENTITLED TO ONE VOTE AND MAY CAST THAT VOTE ON EACH MATTER SUBMITTED TO A VOTE OF THE INDIAN EDUCATION COMMITTEE.

ARTICLE IV:

THE OFFICERS OF THIS COMMITTEE SHALL BE A CHAIRPERSON, VICE-CHAIRPERSON, AND SECRETARY. OFFICERS SHALL BE ELECTED ANNUALLY BY SECRET BALLOT. HOWEVER, IF THERE IS BUT ONE NOMINEE FOR ANY OFFICE, THE ELECTION OF THAT OFFICE SHALL BE BY VOICE VOTE.

ARTICLE V: TERMS OF OFFICE

OFFICERS SHALL ASSUME THEIR OFFICIAL DUTIES FOLLOWING THE CLOSE OF THE LAST REGULAR MEETING IN SEPTEMBER AND SHALL SERVE FOR A TERM OF ONE (1) YEAR AND/OR UNTIL THE ELECTION AND QUALIFICATION OF THEIR SUCCESSORS.

ARTICLE VI: DUTIES OF OFFICERS

THE CHAIRPERSON SHALL PRESIDE AT ALL MEETINGS OF THE COMMITTEE, SHALL PERFORM SUCH OTHER DUTIES AS MAY BE ASSIGNED TO HIM/HER BY THE COMMITTEE, AND SHALL COORDINATE THE WORK OF THE OFFICERS IN ORDER THAT THE OBJECTIVES OF THE COMMITTEE MAY BE PROMOTED.

THE VICE-CHAIRPERSON SHALL ACT AS AN AIDE TO THE CHAIRPERSON AND SHALL PERFORM THE DUTIES OF THE CHAIRPERSON IN ABSENCE OR DISABILITY OF THAT OFFICER TO ACT.

THE SECRETARY SHALL RECORD THE MINUTES OF ALL MEETINGS OF THE COMMITTEE AND SHALL PERFORM OTHER SUCH DUTIES AS MAY BE DELEGATED TO HIM/HER.

ALL OFFICERS SHALL:

PERFORM THE DUTIES PRESCRIBED IN THE PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY IN ADDITION TO THOSE OUTLINED IN THESE BY-LAWS AND THOSE ASSIGNED FROM TIME TO TIME.

DELIVER TO THEIR SUCCESSORS ALL OFFICIAL MATERIAL NOT LATER THAN 10 DAYS FOLLOWING THE ELECTION OF THEIR SUCCESSORS.

ARTICLE VII: MEETINGS

REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE COMMITTEE SHALL BE HELD ON THE SCHOOL GROUNDS MONTHLY OR AS NEEDED DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR, UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY THE COMMITTEE. FIVE DAYS SHALL BE GIVEN OF CHANGE OF DATE.

SPECIAL MEETINGS MAY BE CALLED BY THE COMMITTEE WITH FIVE (5) DAYS NOTICE BEING GIVEN.

THE ANNUAL MEETING SHALL BE IN OCTOBER.

A SIMPLE MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT SHALL CONSTITUTE A QUORUM FOR THE TRANSACTION OF BUSINESS IN ANY MEETING OF THIS COMMITTEE.

ARTICLE VIII: CONDUCT OF MEETINGS

ROBERT'S RULES OF ORDER NEWLY REVISED SHALL GOVERN THE COMMITTEE IN ALL CASES IN WHICH IT IS APPLICABLE AND IN WHICH IT IS NOT IN CONFLICT WITH THESE BY-LAWS.

ARTICLE IX: AMENDMENTS

THESE BY-LAWS MAY BE AMENDED AT ANY REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMITTEE BY A 2/3 VOTE OF THE MEMBERS PRESENT AND VOTING, PROVIDED WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE AMENDMENTS SHALL HAVE BEEN GIVEN AT THE PREVIOUS MEETING, AND THAT THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT SHALL BE SUBJECT TO APPROVAL.

A COMMITTEE MAY BE APPOINTED TO SUBMIT A REVISED SET OF BY-LAWS AS A SUBSTITUTE FOR EXISTING BY-LAWS ONLY BY A MAJORITY OF THE COMMITTEE. THE REQUIREMENTS FOR ADOPTION OF A REVISED SET OF BY-LAWS SHALL BE AS IN THE CASE OF AN AMENDMENT.

RATIFICATION: THESE BY-LAWS WERE APPROVED BY THE INDIAN EDUCATION COMMITTEE AT ITS MEETING ON THE 18TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1994.

BY-LAWS

ARTICLE I: NAME OF COMMITTEE

THE NAME OF THIS COMMITTEE IS THE FORT COBB-BROXTON TITLE IX INDIAN EDUCATION COMMITTEE.

ARTICLE II: OBJECTIVES

THE OBJECTIVES OF THE COMMITTEE ARE:

- A. TO PROMOTE THE WELFARE OF INDIAN CHILDREN AND YOUTH IN HOME, SCHOOL, COMMUNITY, AND THE TRIBE.
- B. TO RAISE THE STANDARDS OF SCHOOL ACHIEVEMENT OF INDIAN CHILDREN.
- C. TO SECURE ADEQUATE PROGRAMS FOR THE CARE AND PROTECTION OF INDIAN CHILDREN AND YOUTH.
- D. TO BRING INTO CLOSER RELATION THE HOME AND THE SCHOOL, SO THAT PARENTS AND TEACHERS MAY COOPERATE IN THE EDUCATION OF INDIAN CHILDREN AND YOUTH.
- E. TO DEVELOP BETWEEN EDUCATORS AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC SUCH UNITED EFFORTS AS WILL SECURE FOR ALL CHILDREN AND YOUTH THE HIGHEST ADVANTAGES IN PHYSICAL, MENTAL, SOCIAL, AND SPIRITUAL EDUCATION.

ARTICLE III: MEMBERSHIP

ANY PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF INDIAN STUDENTS WITH ANY DEGREE OF INDIAN BLOOD ENROLLED IN THE CONTRACTED SCHOOLS MAY BECOME A MEMBER OF THIS COMMITTEE.

- A. SIZE OF COMMITTEE:
SEVEN MEMBERS – CONSISTING OF FIVE (5) PARENTS OF INDIAN STUDENTS; ONE (1) TEACHER; AND ONE (1) STUDENT FROM GRADES 7-12
- B. SELECTION OF MEMBERS:
PARENTS OF GUARDIANS OF INDIAN STUDENTS AND INDIAN STUDENTS IN GRADES 7-12 SHALL ELECT COMMITTEE MEMBERS.
- C. TERM OF MEMBERSHIP:
TERMS SHALL BE FOR ONE (1) YEAR.

- D. VOTING RIGHTS:
EACH MEMBER SHALL BE ENTITLED TO ONE VOTE AND MAY CAST THAT VOTE ON
EACH MATTER SUBMITTED TO A VOTE OF THE INDIAN EDUCATION COMMITTEE.

ARTICLE IV: ELECTION OF OFFICERS

THE OFFICERS OF THIS COMMITTEE SHALL BE A CHAIRPERSON, VICE-CHAIRPERSON, AND SECRETARY. OFFICERS SHALL BE ELECTED ANNUALLY BY SECRET BALLOT. HOWEVER, IF THERE IS BUT ONE NOMINEE FOR ANY OFFICE, THE ELECTION FOR THAT OFFICE SHALL BE BY VOICE VOTE.

ARTICLE V: TERMS OF OFFICE

OFFICERS SHALL ASSUME THEIR OFFICIAL DUTIES FOLLOWING THE CLOSE OF THE LAST REGULAR MEETING IN SEPTEMBER AND SHALL SERVE FOR A TERM OF ONE (1) YEAR AND UNTIL THE ELECTION AND QUALIFICATION OF THEIR SUCCESSORS.

ARTICLE VI: DUTIES OF OFFICERS

- A. THE CHAIRPERSON SHALL PRESIDE AT ALL MEETINGS OF THE COMMITTEE, SHALL PERFORM SUCH OTHER DUTIES AS MAY BE ASSIGNED TO HIM/HER BY THE COMMITTEE, AND SHALL COORDINATE THE WORK OF THE OFFICERS IN ORDER THAT THE OBJECTIVES OF THE COMMITTEE MAY BE PROMOTED.
- B. THE VICE-CHAIRPERSON SHALL ACT AS AN AIDE TO THE CHAIRPERSON AND SHALL PERFORM THE DUTIES OF THE CHAIRPERSON IN THE ABSENCE OR DISABILITY OF THAT OFFICER TO ACT.
- C. THE SECRETARY SHALL RECORD THE MINUTES OF ALL MEETINGS OF THE COMMITTEE AND SHALL PERFORM OTHER SUCH DUTIES AS MAY BE DELEGATED TO HIM/HER.

ALL OFFICERS SHALL:

- A. PERFORM THE DUTIES PRESCRIBED IN THE PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY IN ADDITION TO THOSE OUTLINED IN THESE BY-LAWS AND THOSE ASSIGNED FROM TIME TO TIME.
- B. DELIVER TO THEIR SUCCESSORS ALL OFFICIAL MATERIAL NOT LATER THAN 10 DAYS FOLLOWING THE ELECTION OF THEIR SUCCESSORS.

ARTICLE VII: MEETINGS

REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE COMMITTEE SHALL BE HELD ON THE SCHOOL GROUNDS MONTHLY OR AS NEEDED, DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR, UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY THE COMMITTEE. FIVE DAYS NOTICE SHALL BE GIVEN OF CHANGE OF DATE.

SPECIAL MEETINGS MAY BE CALLED BY THE COMMITTEE WITH FIVE (5) DAYS NOTICE BEING GIVEN.

THE ANNUAL MEETING SHALL BE IN SEPTEMBER OR OCTOBER.

A SIMPLE MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT SHALL CONSTITUTE A QUORUM FOR THE TRANSACTION OF BUSINESS IN ANY MEETING OF THIS COMMITTEE.

ARTICLE VIII: CONDUCT OF MEETINGS

ROBERT'S RULES OF ORDER NEWLY REVISED SHALL GOVERN THE COMMITTEE IN ALL CASES IN WHICH IT IS APPLICABLE AND IN WHICH IT IS NOT IN CONFLICT WITH THESE BY-LAWS.

ARTICLE IX: AMENDMENTS

THESE BY-LAWS MAY BE AMENDED AT ANY REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMITTEE BY A 2/3 VOTE OF THE MEMBERS PRESENT AND VOTING, PROVIDED WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS SHALL BE SUBJECT TO APPROVAL.

A COMMITTEE MAY BE APPOINTED TO SUBMIT A REVISED SET OF BY-LAWS AS A SUBSTITUTE FOR EXISTING BY-LAWS ONLY BY A MAJORITY VOTE AT A MEETING OF THE COMMITTEE. THE REQUIREMENTS FOR ADOPTION OF A REVISED SET OF BY-LAWS SHALL BE AS IN THE CASE OF AN AMENDMENT.

RATIFICATION: THESE BY-LAWS ARE APPROVED BY THE FORT COBB-BROXTON TITLE IX INDIAN EDUCATION COMMITTEE AT ITS MEETING ON THE 26 DAY OF OCTOBER, 1995, AND REAPPROVED ON OCTOBER 13, 1998.
