We wanted to give you a heads up before we have our first pick-up day for instructional materials on Wednesday, March 25th from 9:00-11:00 am. We are extending the time this week to eliminate traffic as much as possible.

We will use the following timeline this week only:

HeadStart-2nd grade – 9:00-9:30 am pick-up

3rd-6th grade – 9:30-10:00 am pick-up

Junior high – 10:00-10:30 am pick-up

High School – 10:30-11:00 am pick-up

All students in grades K-6th will have textbooks and workbooks to pick up.

If you are picking up materials for more than one student, we will get it all at one time. Also, if you need someone to get your packets for you, please contact the office and let them know. Please do not be overwhelmed by the amount of information in the packets. Our teachers have laid out specific instructions on how much material to complete each day. We are simply trying to prepare for the future.

At this point, most of you have already had contact with some or all of your teachers. Students if you have not been doing so, you need to check your school google email daily. That is how your teachers will be communicating with all of you. Students, it would also be a good idea to put some Google Apps on your phones like Google Classroom and Google Docs if you have not done so already. That will allow you to get notifications from your teachers when assignments are sent out and when they are due. We are also asking that students scan in their work and email the information back to their teachers instead of returning the packets. This will eliminate the hand-to-hand contact and get graded assignments back to you faster. If you have an iPhone, you may be able to use your notes app, select the camera option, and can scan documents into a pdf. format. The pdf. documents can then be sent back to your teachers. Like you, we are working hard to learn new educational options each day. You can also take a picture of assignments and send them as a picture if needed.
