- Don't be Afraid of Wordless Picture Books Use these to ask questions such as: "What do you think is happening here?" & "What makes you think that?"
- Start Small Children will have a shorter attention span. However, after having more stories read aloud over time, their attention spans will increase.
- **Be Creative With Your Voice** Use varying voices as different characters speak. If the story has a sound effect, ham it up!
- Read it Again Reading the same book multiple times can really help children develop language skills and
