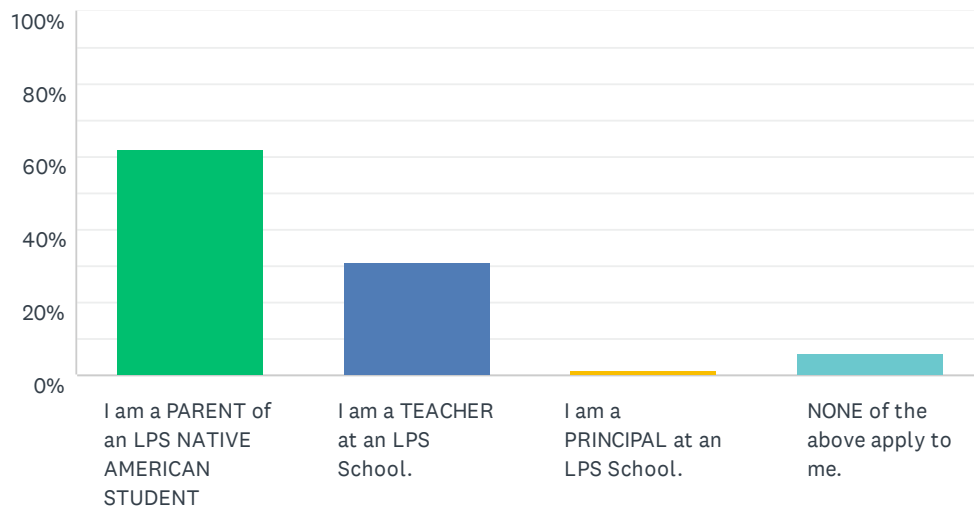


Q1 Which best describes your role in regards to the Lawton Public Schools Indian Education Program?

✱ NONE of the above apply to me.	5.88%

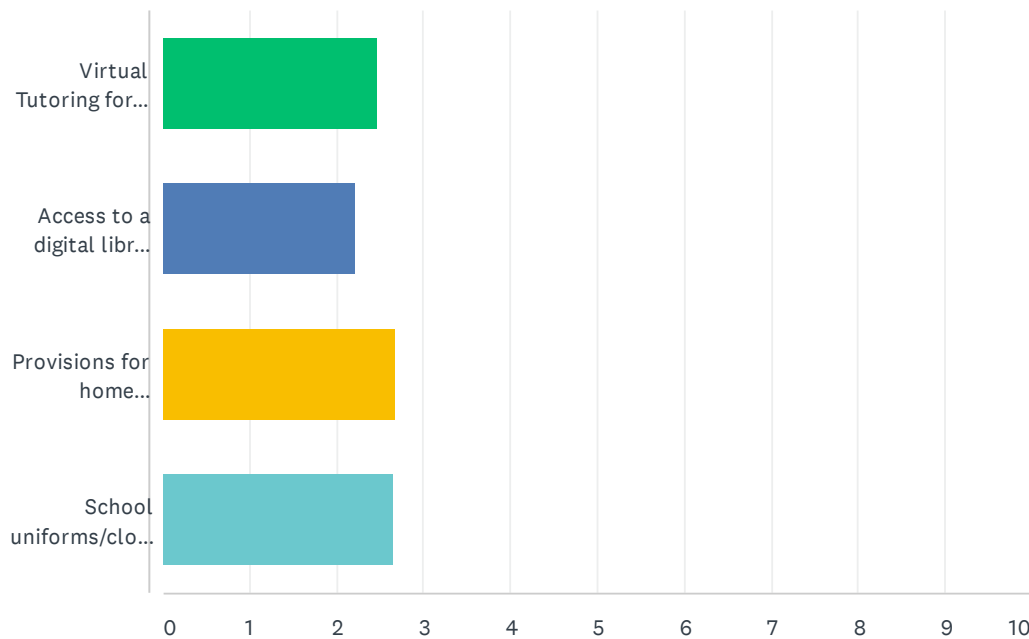
After answering the first question (Q1), survey responders were asked to answer questions relevant to their self-identified role.

* Teachers and Principals answered questions 7-9.

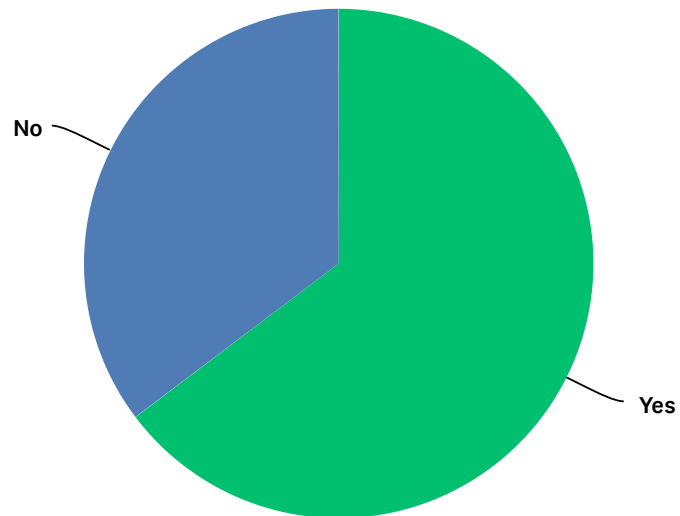

* Q2 Please rank the following options according to how helpful you believe they are for your child. (Rank them from 1 - MOST Helpful to 4 - LEAST helpful.)



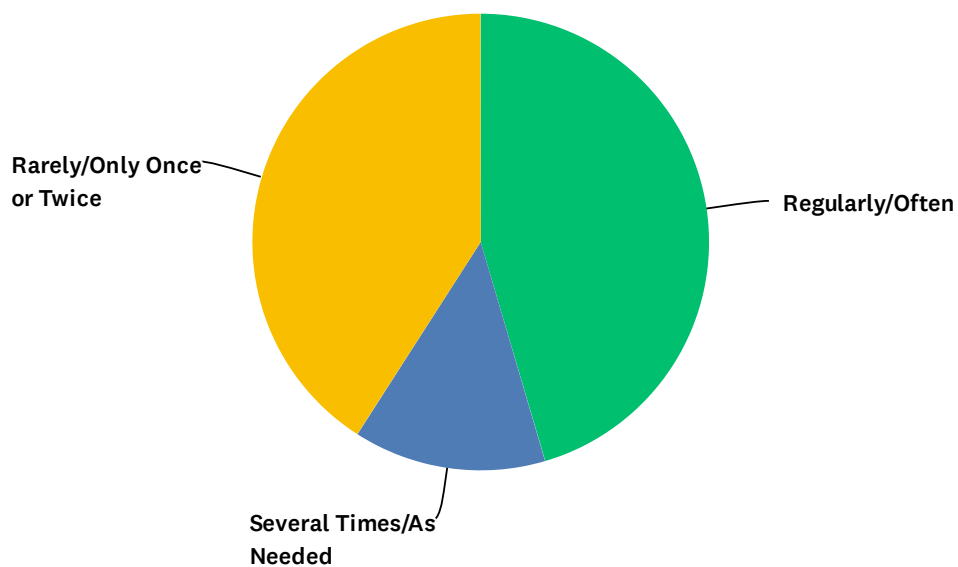

* Q3 Has your child/children participated in the Indian Education Virtual Tutoring program during the second semester of 2021?



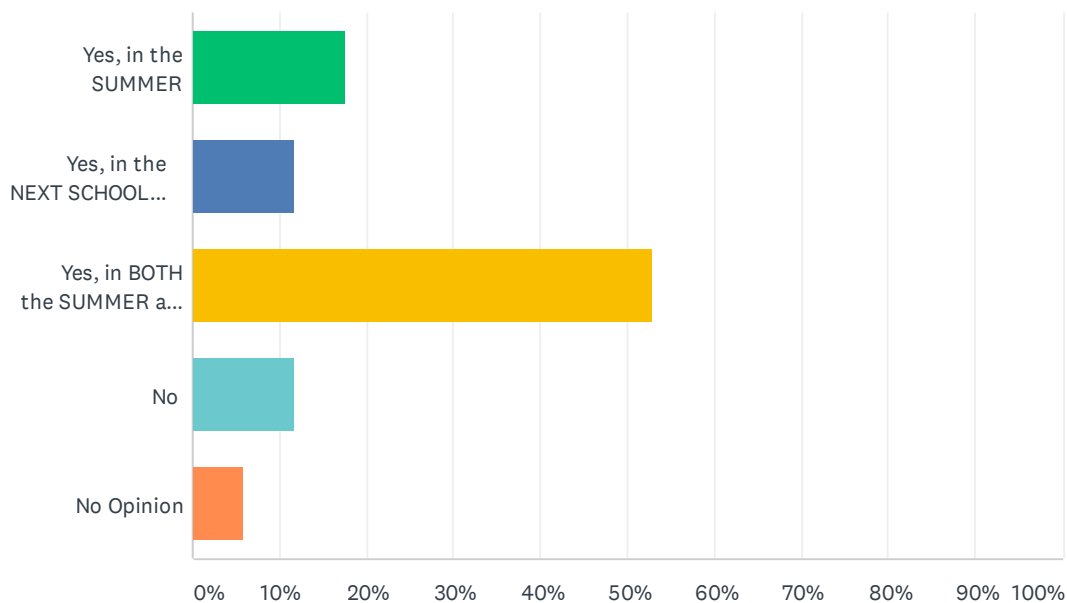

* Q4 About how often has your child/children participated in the Indian Education Virtual Tutoring program?



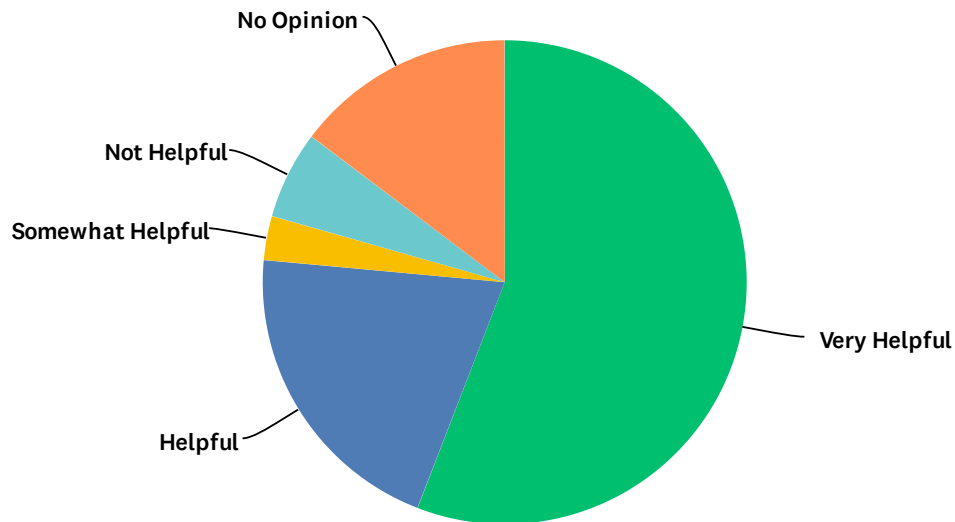

*Q5 If virtual tutoring is available, are your interested in having your child participate in the Indian Education Virtual Tutoring program in the summer or during the next school year?



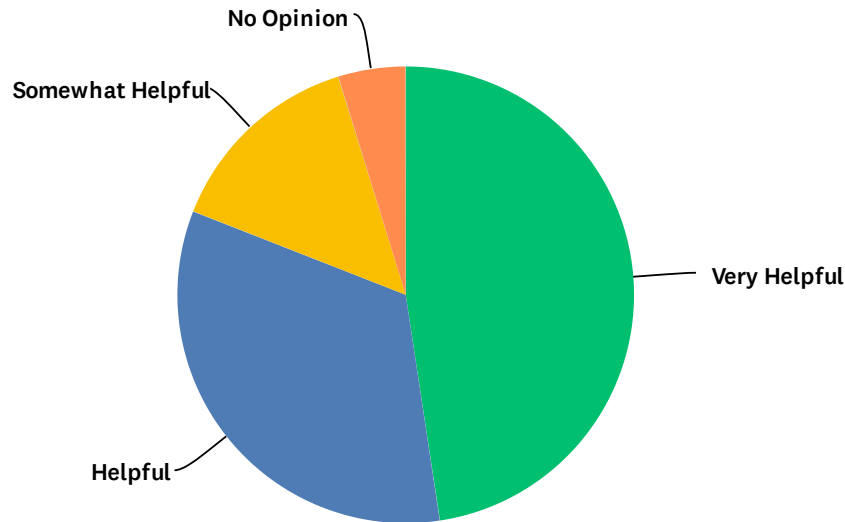

*Q6 How helpful do you feel the Indian Education Virtual Tutoring program is for supporting the academic needs of LPS Native American students?



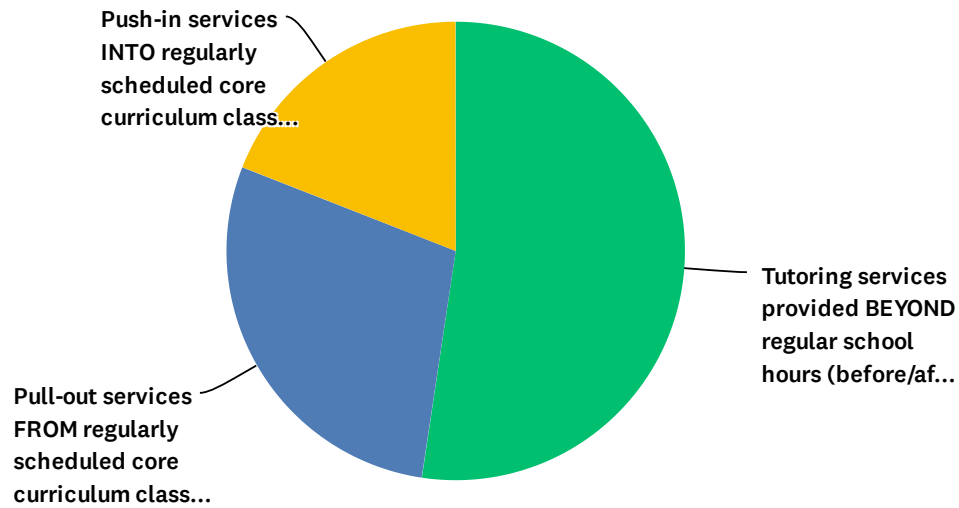

★ Q7 How helpful do you feel the Indian Education Virtual Tutoring program is for supporting the academic needs of LPS Native American students?



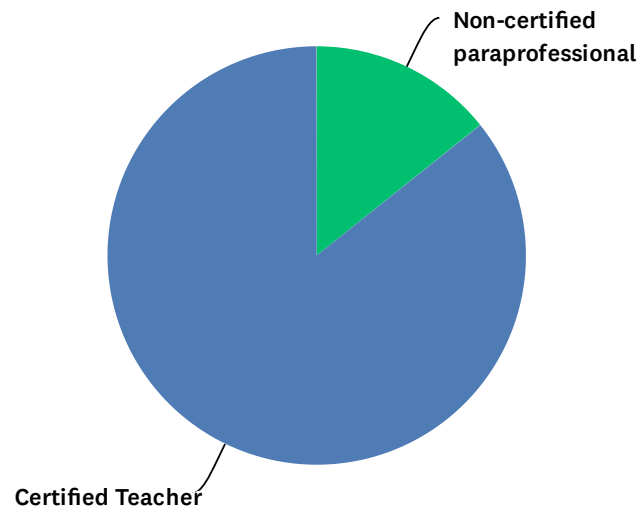
