## Dressing for the Outside Recess

Recess is extremely important to the mental and physical well-being of children. Whenever possible, we seek to have students playing outside for recess as a break from classroom-based and other indoor activities. There are no national or professional standards for temperature that preclude sending children outside for recess. School districts often provide general guidelines. We go outside each day unless it is 31 degrees or lower, with wind chill, or unless it is too wet.

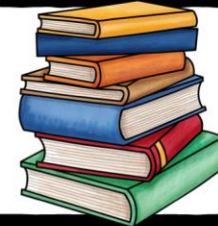

The district's priority upon hearing of a probable positive case is to directly reach out to staff or parents affected & communicate next steps as it aligns with the safety guidelines & procedures. Due to the Family Educational Rights & Privacy Act (FERPA), the district cannot release names or details. District leadership remains in constant communication & in full cooperation with Comanche County Health Department. All staff & parents of students who have been in close contact (6 feet or less for more than fifteen minutes at a time) with a positive case are being notified by the health department that their student will need to quarantine for 14 days.

If you have not been contacted, you or your student have not met the requirements of a "Close Contact."
