2022-2023 Information Regarding Dual Credit Classes:

 Before you can take any PJC classes you must take the TSIA2 test or have the following STAAR scores-

STAAR ENG II 4000 or higher (students with this score or higher can take all courses excluding MATH)

Algebra I score of 4000+ (to take college level math) AND....You must have completed Algebra 2

- You must call the PJC testing center at 903-782-0446 to schedule the test, the cost is \$25 for the full test, and if you have to retake the test it is \$15.
 You also have to take the pre assessment before you take the TSIA2 (I will email you that link)
- Pending funding-Prairiland will pay for one class per Fall and Spring semesters (not during the Summer), as long as the class is in concurrent sequence through PJC-most classes cost between \$150-\$250-there is a Needs Based Scholarship you can apply for if you qualify for free or reduced lunch.
- If a student gets a grade below 70, or doesn't complete a class that Prairiland has paid for, the student must reimburse Prairiland the cost of that class. If a student gets a grade below 70 or fails to complete a PJC class, we will not pay for any PJC classes for that student.
- You may have to travel to PJC to take proctored (monitored) tests, this must be done after school

- Any PJC class you take during the Summer will not figure in for your class rank, or GPA nor will any online class you take during your Senior Spring semester.
- ALL PJC classes will be listed on the student's high school transcript-in the
 event that a student fails a class and then repeats that class, <u>both</u> grades
 will be averaged in for that student's high school ranking and GPA.
- If you take a dual credit class that is required for graduation in the Spring semester of your Senior year, you will also have to take that high school equivalent class (example if you take DC English 1302 in the Spring you will also have to take English 4 with Ms. Rhoades) This also includes Government and Economics.
- YOU are responsible for your own work-cheating, plagiarism, etc. could cause you to fail that class-it is up to the PJC instructor's discretion
- There may be extra costs associated with certain classes such as books, study guides, etc. This is up to the student to pay those costs.
 - Enrollment will be done with a PJC representative on April 20, 2022 in the library for Sophomores
 - April 22nd for Juniors

Most Degree plans require the following classes as basics:

- English 1301, 1302 online (Counts for Senior English)
- Govt 2305, 2306 online (Counts for Senior Government)
- Hist 1301, 1302 online
- Comm 1307 online
- Math 1314 online (College Algebra-1 semester-counts as 1 whole credit)

Other classes depending on your major may be:

- Bio 2401, 2402 (DC A&P-Taught by Mr. Bush) 12th grade year
- Economics 2301,2302 online-will count for Senior Economics
- PSY 2301 online
- Soc 1301 online
- Speech 1315 online
- Art 1301, Mus 1306, Theater 1310 online (Any of these will count for HS fine art)
