

LPS Parents/Guardians,

We are asking for your help to ensure Lawton Public Schools will get its share of U.S. Department of Education (Federal) Funds. To get the funds, the U. S. Department of Education requires we have your completed and signed “Federal Impact Aid Survey”. This survey will go out via text and email on October 28, 2020 and will be a fillable document. Families can use the method that works best for them (i.e. on a mobile device or computer). **If you do not have access to technology to complete the survey, please contact your student’s school for a hard copy version.**

Lawton Public Schools participates in the federal program called Impact Aid, sponsored and **funded by the U.S. Department of Education**. The school receives its share of yearly funding based on the amount of federally or tribally owned land in the District. Qualification is met if a student lives on, or his/her parent is employed on, federally or tribally owned land on the survey date.

To qualify, **ONE** of the following criteria must be met:

1. A student must have a parent(s) on active duty in the uniformed services of the United States (National Guard only qualifies if on Active Duty on OCTOBER 21, 2020. A copy of National Guard orders must be attached to this form to qualify.)
2. A student must live in qualifying low-rent housing.
3. A student must live on federal property.
4. A student must live with a parent who is employed on qualifying federal/tribal property.

Please fill out a form for each school age child, **even if they do not meet any criteria** so we can ensure we received all forms correctly. *Impact Aid is completely funded by the U.S. Dept of Education*. The funding is set aside each year and is based on LAND owned by the Federal Government or Tribes. The funding is provided to help all students in the District! **Your cooperation in helping our District receive its portion of these funds will be greatly appreciated.**

The form will be sent out via text and email and will be fillable. Student name, grade, address, are typed in, but most questions are check boxes. We have tried to make the form as easy as possible to complete.


-If the parent/guardian is active duty military, please fill in the rank.
