

GENERAL INFORMATION & POLICIES

Driver's Education is a voluntary education opportunity Goddard USD 265 provides to in-district and out-of-district students. Eligibility standards are set by the state and enrollment standards are maintained by Goddard USD 265.

ABOUT THE COURSE: Driver's Education consists of two parts: 1) A one week in-class session and 2) scheduled driving sessions. Both parts must be completed by early August in order for the student to complete the course.

The in-class session consists of:

- Instructor-led presentations, discussions, and corresponding assessments.

The driving session will:

- Vary between rural, urban and business districts.
- Consist of a minimum of 4 driving sessions and could be as many as 6; each session averages 2.5 hours.

Driving instructors will communicate via email or phone regarding driving sessions no later than the first day of the students in-class session.

WHEN: Session 1: May 20 – 24 Session 2: June 3 – 7 Session 3: June 10 – 14 Session 4: June 17 - 21

All classroom coursework will be held:

7:30 AM to 12:30 PM at Eisenhower High School, 1230 S. 167th St. W., Goddard, KS 67052

ELIGIBILITY: Students must be at least 14 years old by the 1st day of class. Students must be registered with full payment and student application completed/submitted by May 3, 2019.

A parent/guardian AND his or her participating student are REQUIRED to attend **one** of the following mandatory informational meetings. Meetings will be held:

**Wednesday, April 17, 2019 at 6:30 PM at Eisenhower High School auditorium. OR
 Wednesday, April 24, 2019 at 6:30 PM at Eisenhower High School auditorium.**

ENROLLMENT: Enrollment is open **Tuesday, March 19, 2019 – Wednesday, May 1, 2019.**

All students must enroll and complete their DE-99 through the 2019 USD 265 Driver's Education Google Form located at <https://goo.gl/forms/8T1a53t3m0MuHo6w2>.

Enrollment is offered on a first come, first serve basis, with priority given to in-district students. Course sessions are limited to 100 students per session.

ATTENDANCE: Attendance for the *entire* course is mandatory. If a student must be absent, a parent or guardian must call 316-794-4142 with the notification. The absence must be made up on the Saturday following the assigned weekly session. Students with two or more absences will be dropped from the course. It is suggested that appointments not be scheduled during the students in-class session times.

TRANSPORTATION: Optional bus transportation to/from **classroom session only** is offered for **in-district** students.

FEES: In-district student Driver's Education:	\$ 275.00
Out-of-District student Driver's Education:	\$ 325.00
Optional In-District Transportation:	\$ 50.00

Credit Card payments may be remitted online through Skyward Family Access, Fee Management (RevTrak). Checks and cash can be dropped off at Goddard Academy, Eisenhower High School, or Goddard High School.

Please make checks payable to "USD 265."

All fees must be paid by May 16, 2019. No refunds will be given after May 17, 2019.
