



Opt-Out Notification for Military Recruiters 2020-2021 School Year

Two federal laws* require school districts to provide military recruiters, upon request, the name, address and telephone number of each secondary school student unless the student or student's parent has advised the district that this information is not to be disclosed. In order to have your directory information withheld, please note the following:

A request to withhold directory information must be submitted in writing. The following information **MUST** be included in your request: name of student, student's date of birth, student signature and date signed, parent signature and date signed (not required if student is 18 years of age or older).

Requests to suppress directory information used for other purposes (such as publications, colleges and universities, class rings, and yearbooks) are **NOT** covered by this notification. Such requests must be filed separately. (See REQUEST FOR NON-DISCLOSURE OF DIRECTORY INFORMATION form for instructions covering these purposes.)

Requests for suppression of directory information are for one year, and must be renewed annually.

Written requests to be excluded from directory lists provided to military recruiters must be completed by August 19, 2020 (or on the date of enrollment in Goddard School District if after August 19, 2020).

* These laws are: Section 9528 of the ESEA (20 U.S.C.7908), as amended by the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (P.L. 107-110), the education bill, and 10 U.S.C. 503, as amended by Section 544, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2002 (P.L. 107-107), the legislation that provides funding for the Nation's armed forces.
