6th Grade Course Selection Information

- Every student must select 6 courses – one from each category:
 - RLA
 - History
 - Math
 - Science
 - Physical Education
 - Elective
- One elective is taken for an entire school year. Due to the number and content of these courses, electives may not be changed during the school year.
- Students requiring Dyslexia will take this class as their elective. The only exception to this is if a student is wanting to take Band. In those cases, students will not have a PE class and will instead take Band plus Dyslexia.
- In order to take an Honors-level course, students must earn a final average of an 85 or above in 5th grade in that subject area and score “Meets” or better on the 1st administration of the 5th grade STAAR test for that subject. For RLA and History, we look at the Reading STAAR test since there is no Writing or History STAAR test in the 5th grade. A teacher recommendation signature is also required on this form for each Honors subject requested. Teachers should indicate next to their signature whether or not they recommend the student for Honors level by circling YES or NO next to their signature.
- Students who are failing an Honors class at the progress report must attend mandatory tutorials until they can bring their average back to passing.
- Since there are such high expectations for student academic performance in an Honors class, a student can be removed from an Honors course by a school administrator for the following reasons: 1. A student receives an academic grade of 79 - 70 for two or more consecutive nine weeks grading periods. 2. A student receives an academic grade of 69 or less for any nine weeks grading period.
- A schedule will be automatically created by the campus principal and school counselor for students who do not return the course request form by February 8th.
- The final day to request a schedule change of any kind will be September 1, 2021.
