

High School Credit Advancement SUMMER 2021

This credit advancement opportunity allows students to take high school credits outside of the regular school year to "get ahead" and create flexibility in their four-year plan. These summer advanced credit courses are offered at no cost to current USD 265 students, and all books needed for each course will be supplied by the teacher. Bus transportation is available at no cost for current USD 265 students living within the USD 265 boundaries. Breakfast will also be available at no cost for all students participating in summer credit advancement courses.

Important Notes:

- Credit advancement courses allow a student to have one hour of release during the second semester of their junior or senior year as long as the student is on track for graduation.
- Students may enroll in up to two high school summer learning classes (including Credit Advancement, WSU Tech Dual Credit, and/or Credit Recovery courses).
- Credit advancement courses will be taught by USD 265 high school teachers.

All credit advancement classes meet:

June 7th - July 1st, 2021 (Monday - Thursday)

Mondays and Wednesdays - Students meet in person from 10:00am - 12:30pm. Tuesdays and Thursdays - Students work online from home. Classes offered for Eisenhower High, Goddard High, and Academy students.

Please Note: Introduction to Automotive Technology will meet in person from 10:00am - 12:30pm (Monday - Thursday) at the USD 265 Auto Shop located just south of Discovery Intermediate School -301 S. Main Street, Goddard, KS.

Course Offerings:

- ACT Prep (10th-12th grade) = 0.5 elective credit
- American Government (11th-12th grade) = 0.5 credit
- Intro. to Automotive Technology (9th-12th grade) = 0.5 credit
- Health (9th-12th grade) = 0.5 credit
- Success 101 (9th-12th grade EHS only) = 0.5 credit *Based on the student's 2021-2022 grade level
