Certified Nurse Aide (CNA) Certification Wichita Area Technical College Summer Program May 24-July 23

What is a CNA Certification? Prepares students to be caregivers in nursing homes while working under the supervision of licensed nurses. Includes classroom instruction, laboratory and clinical experience. Program meets Kansas State Department of Health and Environment guidelines. Graduates may take the state examination to become a certified nurse aide.

There is no cost for registration or tuition for the course for <u>GHS students currently in grades 10-11</u> (must be 16 by May 24 to participate). Cost to student will include book purchase/rental and scrubs.

STEP 1: Applicants must apply with WATC. Click APPLY NOW and choose HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT.

STEP 2: Applicants must also complete PLACEMENT TESTS which can be taken at the SOUTH Campus. No appointment necessary. Plan about 1.5 hours for testing. See www.watc.edu TESTING for days and hours.
