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

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**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

The name of this corporation is Imagine Academy.

**II.**

A. This corporation is a non-profit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes.

B. The specific purpose of this corporation is to engage in educational and charitable activities.

**III.**

**IV.**

A. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the "Code"), including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations organized for said purposes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

B. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or (2) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code.

C. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

D. The income of the corporation for each taxable year is to be distributed at such time and in such manner as not to subject it to tax under Section 4942 of the Code.

E. The corporation is prohibited from engaging in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Code.

F. The corporation shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Code.

G. The corporation shall not make any investment that subjects it to tax under Section 4944 of the Code.

H. The corporation shall not make any taxable expenditure as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Code.

## V.

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person. Upon the dissolution or winding up of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

VI.

The corporation is authorized to indemnify its agents (as defined in Section 5238 of the California Corporations Code) to the fullest extent permissible under California Law.
