### SUPE'S CORNER -

Those of you who were at the Pass in Review last Friday heard me talk about the tragedy at Bernstein HS where four students took pills and one died from an overdose of Fentanyl. During this month devoted to mental health awareness, I encourage families to talk about this tragedy and the fact that NVMI has many, many counselors available to help any student who is feeling sad, anxious, angry, lonely, confused, or any feeling they would like to talk to a professional about. It is critical that we as a society stop making people feel like talking to a counselor is something bad or to be ashamed of. It isn't. It is normal and healthy for someone to talk to a professional counselor when they are hurting the same way we talk to a medical doctor when we are physically sick. If a student needs to talk to a counselor, they can let any adult at NVMI know and they will be directed by that adult to the counseling personnel. You can always send an email to vdeavila@novamil.org if you would like to tell Ms. De Avila about your child or yourself or a friend who needs help. NVMI prioritizes mental health, and for that reason has nearly 20 counselors to help those in need.
