Your counselors will be speaking with you about any classes you may have failed, summer school, the LAMC Early College Program, your school attendance, number of permanent demerits, your current military rank and promotion requirements, and whether you still need to participate in one or more sports. We invite all students to participate with their parents/guardians in these conferences. Each conference will take about 10 minutes (some may take a bit longer if you have questions – we will spend as much time as you need to ensure your questions are answered). If you do not complete this conference by THIS WEDNESDAY March 30, we will assume you are not re-enrolling and give their space to someone on our waiting list. Thank you in advance for your participation.

CELL PHONES: Please remember the NVMI policy is and always has been that NVMI staff should never see or hear a student's cell phone unless the teacher has given permission for a phone to be used in class for an academic reason.

SPRING BREAK WORK ON FRECKLE: All students are being assigned spring break work on Freckle, a computer-based program to improve reading and math skills. We are asking everyone to do at least 15 minutes a day or both subjects. We will be rewarding those who do so, and when students return April 11, they will take an important progress test and there will be prizes for those who perform well.

SUMMER CAMP: Summer Camp is now scheduled for June 9-18 at Fort Irwin in Barstow (instead of Camp Pendleton). This is due to scheduling conflicts with the Marine Corps. Information about registering for camp will be in the Hawk Weekly when we return from spring break on April 11.

DAY OF SERVICE: This Thursday we celebrate Cesar Chavez Day. Instead of having classes, we want each student to perform 8 hours of service. This can be with a community agency, a church, a neighbor who needs help (like mowing the lawn or cleaning or painting or taking out trash), or even a member of your own family who needs help with something. ANY form of service that is genuinely helping another human being or group of people counts. Your TAC team will have a form for you to complete to verify your service. That will count for your attendance this Thursday, and is due by the time we return from Spring Break on Monday April 11.

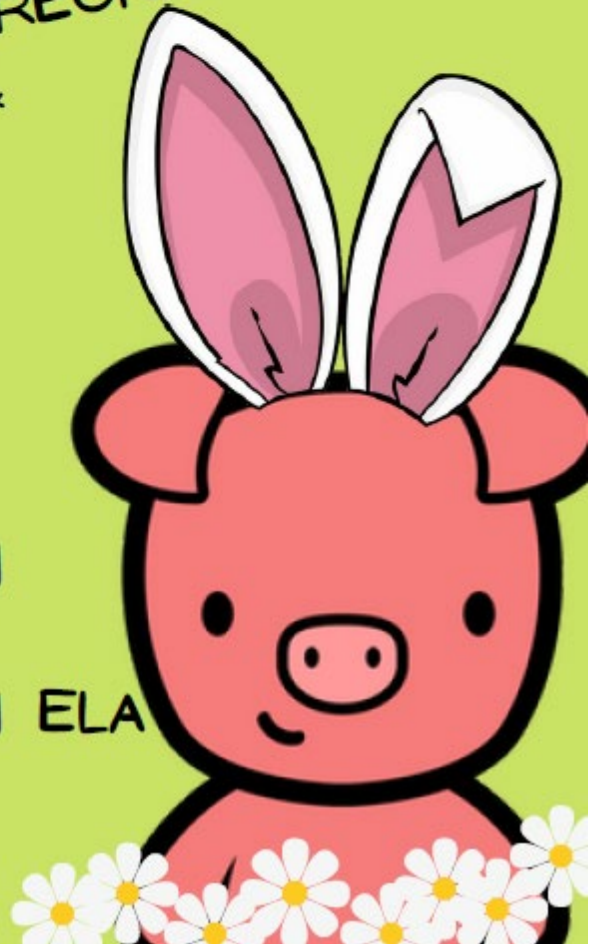

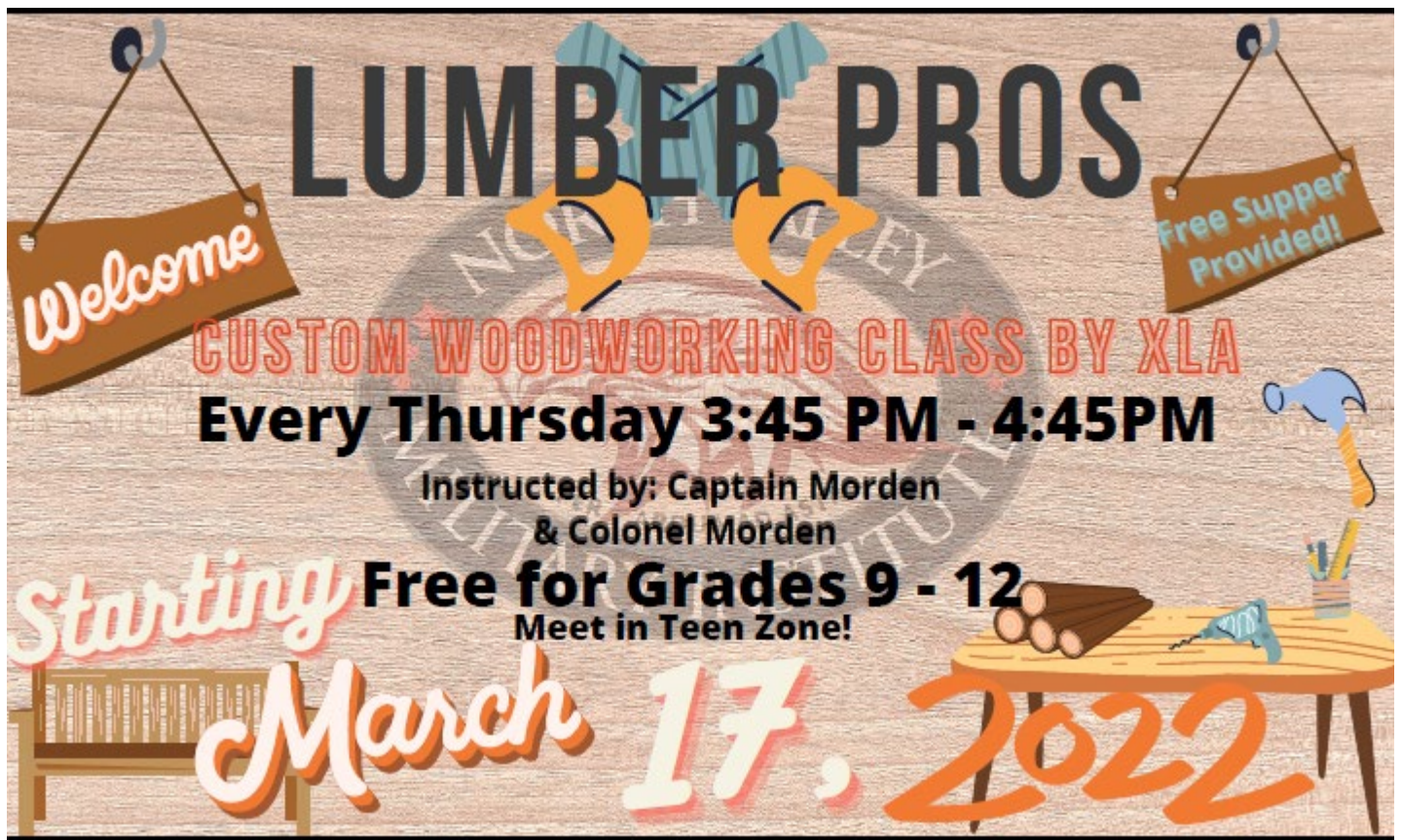

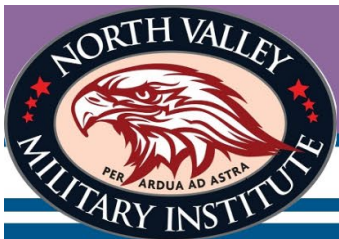
