## **Grant Award Notification (Continued)**

The following Grant conditions apply:

- 1. The grant award will be processed upon receipt of the signed (AO-400). This AO-400 must be signed by the superintendent or an authorized official and **returned within 10 working days**.
- 2. All approved program funds must be expended within the dates designated and for the maximum amount indicated on the AO-400. Encumbrances may be made at any time after the beginning date of the grant stated on the AO-400. No extensions of this grant will be allowed.
- 3. The grantee will support and provide evidence-based, non-punitive education programs and practices in accordance with the Learning Communities for School Success Program (LCSSP) application that was submitted by the grantee. The purpose of this program is to help build the capacity of Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) to identify and implement education activities to keep our most vulnerable students in school, consistent with each LEAs Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP). The AO-400, in accordance with the provisions of California Education Code (EC) sections 33430 through 33436. These funds may not supplant current costs. Expenditures shall comply with all applicable provisions of federal, state, and local rules, regulations, and policies relating to the administration and accounting for public school funds, including but not limited to the EC.
- 4. The grantee must limit administrative indirect costs to the rate approved by the California Department of Education (CDE) for the applicable fiscal year in which the funds are spent.
- 5. Scheduled payments of grant funds will be as follows:
  - The first payment 70 percent of the grant funds will be released upon completion and return of the AO-400. Please allow approximately five weeks for processing.
  - A second payment of 10 percent of the funds will be released upon completion of the Annual Report (AR) and Annual Expenditure Report (AER) for Year 1.
  - A third payment of 10 percent of the funds will be released upon completion of the AR and AER for Year 2.
  - The final 10 percent (or portion thereof) of the entire grant budget may be withheld pending receipt and approval by the High School Innovations and Initiatives Office (HSIIO) of the required End of Project Report that is due no later than January 31, 2025.
- 6. General Assurances are hereby incorporated by reference. The CDE has agreed to accept the assurances currently provided in the LEAs Consolidated Application. The CDE will verify if the agency has submitted the required certifications and assurances.
- 7. The grantee agrees to submit all required deliverables no later than the due dates set forth in the RFA. Late submissions will delay progress payments. All required reports must be approved by the HSIIO before progress payments will be made. Failure to submit the required deliverables by the established due dates may jeopardize LEA funding. Late or non-submission of the required deliverables may result in termination of the grant with the CDE and the billing for any funds given to the LEA in advance. Failure to submit required deliverables may also jeopardize future eligibility for grant funding.
- 8. Under authority of the CDE, if the LEA is identified as noncompliant, special conditions may be imposed. The State Superintendent of Public Instruction may authorize the CDE to withhold partial or total funding. LEAs with sanctions will receive notification of special conditions. No payments will be released to LEAs with special conditions until the CDE receives written notification from the LEA agreeing to the special conditions.
