DONALD M. STEWART SCHOLARSHIPS

I. General Information:

The Donald M. Stewart Scholarship was established in 1999, by the Kansas Health Foundation, in recognition of Donald M. Stewart's visionary leadership of their organization and his commitment to Kansas communities and to the young people of Kansas.

II. Description:

The scholarships, originating in 1999, will be awarded as follows:

- 1. These annually awarded scholarships are available to graduates of any Dickinson County High School.
- 2. Four (4) nonrenewable scholarships, each in the amount of at least \$3,000, will be awarded annually, to apply toward tuition and fees to attend Kansas University, for undergraduate studies.
- 3. Potential recipients are not limited to currently graduating Dickinson County High School seniors. Applicants can also include former Dickinson County High School graduates who are now attending, or wish to attend, Kansas University, to pursue an undergraduate degree.
- 4. Priority will be given to applicants who have not previously been awarded this scholarship; if there is a shortage of those applicants, previously awarded recipients, who elect to reapply, may be considered.

III Criteria:

A. Selection

Applicants must demonstrate exceptional community spirit with a demonstrated commitment to learning and a desire to further his/or her education and to advance the well being of future generations.

Applicants must have a grade point average consistent with the KU admission requirement, and thereafter actually enroll at K.U.

Applicants must have previously exhibited community involvement.
