

## **Annual Assurances of Compliance by Local School Boards Policy**

Voyage Academy will comply with R277-108 by providing annual assurances of the following:

- 1) The National motto is displayed in the school consistent with Section 53G-10-302;
- 2) A policy has been developed, in consultation with school personnel, parents, and school community, to provide for effective implementation of student education plans/student education occupation plans (SEPs/SEOPs) consistent with Section 53E-2-304;
- 3) Compliance with Section 53G-11-205 in that it does not endorse or provide preferential treatment for any education employee association;
- 4) A policy has been developed on education association leave consistent with Section 53G-11-206;
- 5) Each public school has established a community council consistent with Section 53G-7-1202, and the community council members have been advised of their responsibilities consistent with Sections 53G-7-1202 and 53G-7-1204;
- 6) The school board will provide for the evaluation of the statewide assessment results and use of the evaluations in setting goals and establishing programs for professional development that provides teachers, principals, and other professional staff with the training required to successfully establish and maintain statewide assessments in accordance with the requirements in 53E-4-311.
- 7) The school does not make payroll deductions from the wages of its employees for political purposes consistent with Section 34-32-1.1(2);
- 8) The school board has implemented a training program for school administrators consistent with Section 53G-4-402;
- 9) The school board has an educator evaluation program developed by a joint committee with Section 53G-11-506;
- 10) The school board has presented and implemented an electronic device policy consistent with the timelines and provisions of R277-495;
- 11) By May 31<sup>st</sup>, the school has posted certain public financial information on the school district or charter school website consistent with Sections 63A-3-401 through 63A-3-404.
