- V. <u>Item</u> -- BOARD TO CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON A MOTION APPROVING THE RENEWAL OF THE LEASE-PURCHASE OF DISTRICT-WIDE IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2016 AS REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE EQUIPMENT LEASE PURCHASE AGREEMENT DATED AUGUST 24, 2010 BETWEEN THE DISTRICT AND ZIONS FIRST NATIONAL BANK.

<u>Information</u> -- Oklahoma law requires that a school district take affirmative action each year for a lease-purchase to be renewed.

<u>Recommendation</u> -- The Board approve the renewal of the lease-purchase of **District-wide Improvements** for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016 as required under the provisions of the Equipment Lease/Purchase Agreement dated August 24, 2010 and **Zions First National Bank** (QZAB Bonds).

VI. <u>Item</u> -- DISCUSSION AND VOTE TO APPROVE OR NOT APPROVE WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE BIDS.

<u>Information</u> -- OSAG was founded as a way to assist school districts in saving money, in accordance with the *Inter-local Co-op Act* approved by the Attorney General for this group in June 1994. Currently OSAG represents most school districts in the state of Oklahoma.

<u>Recommendation</u> -- The board approve OSAG to provide Workers' Compensation Insurance for \$118,051.00 for the 2015-2016 school year, which includes the Loss Fund amount of \$9,434.00.

# VII. <u>Item</u> -- DISCUSSION AND VOTE TO APPROVE OR NOT APPROVE A RENTAL CONTRACT WITH THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH FOR ADULT BASIC EDUCATION.

Information - - During this past year, the Adult Basic Education Program has been successfully housed at the Presbyterian Church. Poteau School wants to contract with the Presbyterian Church for the 2015-2016 school year to rent their annex for Adult Basic Education. The cost would be \$175.25 plus utilities per month.

**Recommendation** -- Board vote to approve the Rental Contract with the Presbyterian Church for Adult Basic Education for the 2015-2016 school year.
