- V. Item -- BOARD TO CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON A MOTION APPROVING THE RENEWAL OF THE LEASE-PURCHASE OF DISTRICT-WIDE IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2017 AS REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE EQUIPMENT LEASE PURCHASE AGREEMENT DATED AUGUST 24, 2010 BETWEEN THE DISTRICT AND ZIONS FIRST NATIONAL BANK.

<u>Information</u> -- Oklahoma law requires that a school district take affirmative action each year for a lease-purchase to be renewed.

<u>Recommendation</u> -- The Board approve the renewal of the lease-purchase of District-wide Improvements for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017 as required under the provisions of the Equipment Lease/Purchase Agreement dated August 24, 2010 and Zions First National Bank (QZAB Bonds).

VI. Item -- BOARD TO CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON A MOTION TO RATIFY THE LEASE PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH GOVERNMENT CAPITAL CORPORATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING THE LED LIGHTING AND RELATED EQUIPMENT DATED AS OF MARCH 7, 2016

Information -- The change to LED lighting at all sites in the district will be

<u>Information</u> - - The change to LED lighting at all sites in the district will be financed by Government Capital Corporation and requires a lease purchase agreement.

Recommendation -- The board ratify the lease purchase agreement with Government Capital Corporation.

VII. <u>Item</u> -- DISCUSSION AND VOTE TO APPROVE OR NOT APPROVE WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE BIDS.

<u>Information</u> - - We have received two proposals offering Workers Compensation Insurance. The two vendors are the Zenith Company and the Beckman Company.

Recommendation -- The board approve a vendor to provide Workers' Compensation Insurance for the 2016-2017 school year.

VIII. <u>Item</u> -- DISCUSSION AND VOTE TO APPROVE OR NOT APPROVE A RENTAL CONTRACT WITH THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH FOR ADULT BASIC EDUCATION.

<u>Information</u> -- During this past year, the Adult Basic Education Program has been successfully housed at the Presbyterian Church Annex. The District needs to contract with the Presbyterian Church for the 2016-2017 school year to rent their annex for Adult Basic Education. The cost would be \$175.25 plus utilities per month.

<u>Recommendation</u> -- Board vote to approve the Rental Contract with the Presbyterian Church for Adult Basic Education for the 2016-2017 school year.

IX. <u>Item</u> -- DISCUSSION AND VOTE TO APPROVE OR NOT APPROVE AN ENROLLMENT FEE OF \$20.00 IN THE ADULT EDUCATION PROGRAM.

<u>Information</u> - - The District cannot pick up the cost associated with enrollment in the Adult Education Program. Test fees are an example of the costs.

<u>Recommendation</u> - - The Board approve the \$20.00 annual enrollment fee.

X. <u>Item</u> -- DISCUSSION AND VOTE TO APPROVE OR NOT APPROVE A SPEECH-LANGUAGE SERVICE AGREEMENT FOR THE 2016-2017 SCHOOL YEAR.

<u>Information</u> - - Speech-Language Services are needed for the 2016-2017 school year. The district has received a proposed contract with Brandi Wofford.

<u>Recommendation</u> - - Board vote to approve a Speech-Language Service Agreement

Recommendation - - Board vote to approve a Speech-Language Service Agreement with Brandi Wofford.

XI. <u>Item</u> - - DISCUSSION AND VOTE TO APPROVE OR NOT APPROVE THE RESOLUTION FOR SCHOOLS AND LIBRARIES UNIVERSAL SERVICES (E-RATE) FOR 2016-2017.

<u>Information</u> - - The school applies each year for E-Rate Program funding from the Universal Services Administrative Company, Schools and Libraries Division. The board approves each application and the total is \$112,313.26. This Resolution authorizes the filing of the Form 471 applications for funding year 2016-2017 and the payment of the applicant's share upon approval of funding and receipt of services.

<u>Recommendation</u> - - The board vote to approve the E-Rate Resolution, Form 471 for 2016-2017.

XII. <u>Item</u> -- DISCUSSION AND VOTE TO APPROVE OR NOT APPROVE THE OPEN TRANSFER REQUESTS FOR THE 2016-2017 SCHOOL YEAR.

<u>Information</u> -- By law Open Transfers into the district must be approved by the Board of Education. A list of Open Transfer requests will be presented for the Board's consideration.

<u>Recommendation</u> - - The board vote to approve students for Open Transfers for the 2016-2017 school year as presented.

XIII. <u>Item</u> -- DISCUSSION AND VOTE TO APPROVE OR NOT APPROVE THE 2016-2017 CONTRACT / AGREEMENT WITH KIAMICHI TECHNOLOGY CENTER FOR MATH/SCIENCE COURSE INSTRUCTION.

<u>Information</u> -- Kiamichi Technology Center Course Offerings Agreement. The Poteau High School counselor and principal must sign off for a student to enroll in KTC Math courses.

Recommendation -- The board approve the 2016-2017 contract/agreement with Kiamichi Technology Center as presented.

<u>Information</u> - - Cafeteria Funds for the amount of \$24,150.16 were received after the Estimate of Needs was approved. A Supplemental Appropriation for the Child Nutrition Fund 22 is needed to spend the extra revenue received.

Recommendation -- The board vote to approve the Supplemental Appropriation for the 2015-2016 Child Nutrition Fund 22 in the amount of \$24,150.16.
