- V. Item -- BOARD TO CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON A MOTION APPROVING THE RENEWAL OF THE QUALIFIED ZONE ACADEMY BOND LEASE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2018 AS REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE EQUIPMENT LEASE PURCHASE AGREEMENT DATED AUGUST 24, 2010 BETWEEN THE DISTRICT AND ZIONS FIRST NATIONAL BANK.

<u>Information</u> -- Oklahoma law requires that a school district take affirmative action each year for a lease-purchase to be renewed.

Recommendation -- The Board approve the renewal of the lease-purchase of District-wide Improvements for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 as required under the provisions of the Equipment Lease/Purchase Agreement dated August 24, 2010 and Zions First National Bank (QZAB Bonds).

VI. <u>Item</u> -- DISCUSSION AND VOTE TO APPROVE OR NOT APPROVE A WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE VENDOR.

<u>Information</u> - - We are waiting to receive two proposals offering Workers Compensation Insurance and should have a recommendation <u>Recommendation</u> - - The board approve a vendor to provide Workers' Compensation Insurance for the 2018-2019 school year.

VII. <u>Item</u> -- DISCUSSION AND VOTE TO APPROVE OR NOT APPROVE A VENDOR FOR THE DISTRICT INSURANCE COVERAGE.

<u>Information</u> - - We are receiving bids for an insurance package that includes buildings and contents, boilers and water heaters, bonds, professional legal liability, general liability, and vehicles.

<u>Recommendation</u> - - Board vote to approve, not approve or table action on an insurance vendor.

VIII. <u>Item</u> -- DISCUSSION AND VOTE TO APPROVE OR NOT APPROVE MEMBERSHIP WITH OKLAHOMA STATE SCHOOL BOARDS ASSOCIATION.

<u>Information</u> - It has been customary for the Boards of Education of all Oklahoma School Districts to join OSSBA. The services of OSSBA include training for board members, legal information, publications, consultation on school matters, monitoring of legislation, and other services designed to improve education. Membership dues vary with a district's budget amount. The dues for Poteau for 2018-2019 are the same as 2017-2018, which is \$3,225.00.

Recommendation -- The board approve renewing membership in OSSBA for the 2018-2019 school year.

IX. <u>Item</u> -- DISCUSSION AND VOTE TO APPROVE CONTRACTS FOR SERVICE FOR 2018-2019

<u>Information</u> - - The following contracts for Service and Inter-Agency Agreements are needed for the 2018-2019 school year.

<u>Information</u> -- An Agreement between Poteau Public Schools and Oklahoma Public Schools Unemployment Compensation Trust Account (OPSUCA) and Oklahoma State School Boards Association (OSSBA) will be presented. The annual payment for participation will be \$825.50.

<u>Recommendation</u> -- The board approve the Unemployment Service Agreement presented for the 2017-2018 school year.

<u>Information</u> - - There is a need to build additional facilities to accommodate growth in enrollment at the secondary level. There is strong support to build a 7th/8th grade center and a high school classroom building and to add increased safety and security measures at all sites. J.C.
