CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

Qualifications

- Earn an ACT composite of 19 or higher
- OR have a high school grade point average of 3.0
- Additionally, students must earn an ACT subscore of 19 in the curricular area in which they wish to enroll or take appropriate Accuplacer tests and score high enough to place into college level courses

Remaining Eligible

- Maintain a 2.0 grade point average in all college courses
- Remain enrolled in at least three semester hours in college.

Expenses

- **Juniors** are eligible for 9 credit hours of free tuition.
 - **Seniors** are eligible for 18 credit hours of free tuition.
- ⇒ A student could expect to pay \$176.25 per three-hour online course—in addition to the cost of a book and supplies. Additional fees will be applied to certain subject areas and labs.

How to Enroll at WOSC as a Student

- Complete and submit the online application for admission at www.wosc.edu. A one-time \$20 application fee is charged at the time of enrollment in courses.
- Fill out the High School Enrollment Verification Form (attached). Give this form to Mrs. Baker.

How to Enroll in a Specific Class

- Fill out the attached WOSC Enrollment Information Sheet.
 - Email a copy or a picture of the sheet to lbaker@sentinel.k12.ok.us.
 - Mrs. Baker will then forward the information to WOSC along with your high school transcript, ACT scores, GPA, and High School Enrollment Verification Form.
- ⇒ **NOTICE:** You must have enrolled at WOSC as a student **BEFORE** enrolling in a specific class.
